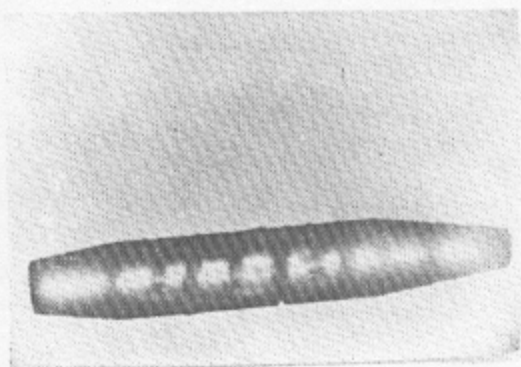

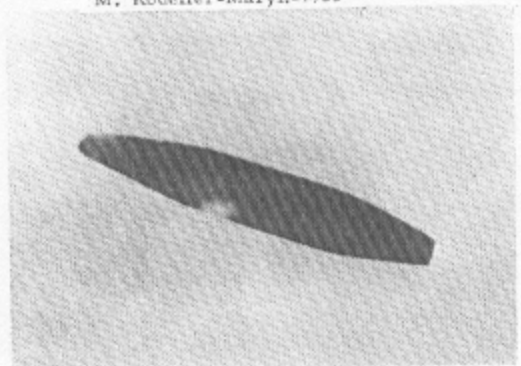

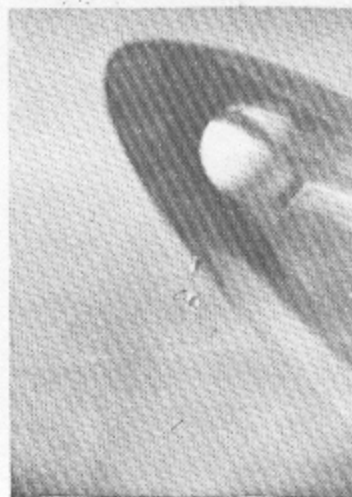

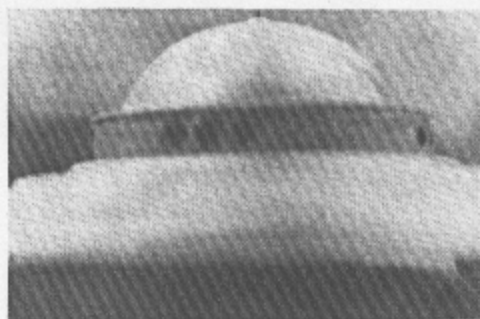

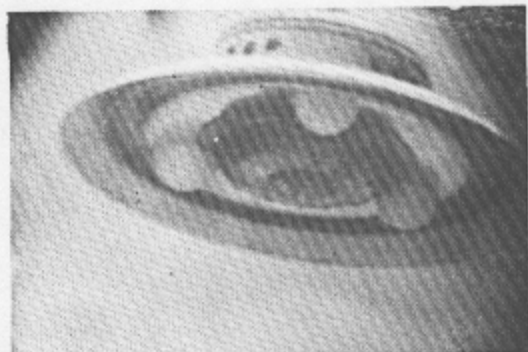

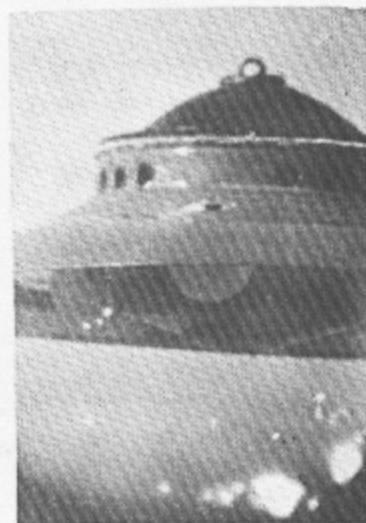

Biographical Sketch of George Adamski

Born in Poland April 17, 1891, George Adamski was not yet two years old when his parents settled in Dunkirk, N.Y. Possessing an extremely brilliant mind and a sensitive nature, he soon found himself wondering at the seeming inharmonies in Life about him. With all of Nature operating in perfect coordination under the guidance of an invisible law, why did man have so much trouble finding peace?

Five years in the Army only strengthened Mr. Adamski's longing to grow in understanding and wisdom that he might be of service to his fellow man. The University of the world as his, and for many years he travelled around the nation, earning his living at any job that was offered.

Nearing forty, he moved to Laguna Beach, California, and there he devoted full time to teaching Universal Law. Students flocked to him. He was in great demand for lectures and his talks were radio broadcast. Here, too, he was presented a six-inch telescope.

Later on he and a group of students moved half way up Palomar mountain. Mr. Adamski was not connected with the observatory but he had many friends among the scientists, and they respected his ability. Thus the studies continued. Many visitors came and with all he gladly shared his findings.

In 1946, Mr. Adamski and his friends began observing strange objects moving across the heavens. Soon others came to check their personal observations. Convinced of their extra-terrestrial nature, he set about getting evidence finally succeeding in getting photos and in later years he also took movies of them. It was to this man in November 1952 that the Venusian pilot of a "flying saucer" came one day in the desert. His later experiences with the people from space are recounted in three of his books. He has also written philosophical material.

With the coming of the space people Mr. Adamski's field of service widened. Far advanced from us all in many ways the space people confirmed Mr. Adamski's understanding of Universal Law, and during the many illuminating hours he spent in their company, discussed much of Cosmic Wisdom that he could share with mankind here on Earth. He has been on many lecture tours all over this country and abroad. He was in much demand wherever he went. In Europe he was welcomed by Queen Juliana and her advisors. In Rome he was given a medal of honor by the Late Pope John. Lives were made richer for knowing George Adamski, for he shared his understanding of Cosmic Intelligence with all who would listen. His name is a symbol of hope and understanding in the midst of confusion, a promise of happiness and Life Eternal when Nature's Cosmic Laws are obeyed.

On April 23, 1985 at Silver Spring, Maryland, during another tour across the country. George Adamski now 74 years old, was stricken with a heart attack and passed away very suddenly, leaving a rich heritage, and followers all over the world. His mortal remains were interred at Arlington National Cemetery, in Arlington, Virginia.

And so, to carry on the work to which he so nobly gave his life, the GEORGE ADAMSKI FOUNDATION was established with Mrs. Wells acting as coordinator. There will be no break in the work and material will be available. We will continue to try to bring to mankind the understanding and the beauty granted to each individual, and so simply taught by George Adamski.

HIS "VISIT" HERE WAS UNFORGETTABLE:

Last April 23, 1965, GEORGE ADAMSKI, 74, (born April 17, 1891), one of the foremost pioneers in Flying Saucer research, left this earthly life. Mr. Adamski was well known to most students and investigators of the Flying Saucer subject. He had made a name for himself around the world as a lecturer and teacher about space craft, people from other planets, and Cosmic Philosophy.

For several years prior to his historic meeting with a space ship in the California desert, Mr. Adamski had observed and photographed space ships through his telescope --- from his home at Mt. Palomar, in California.

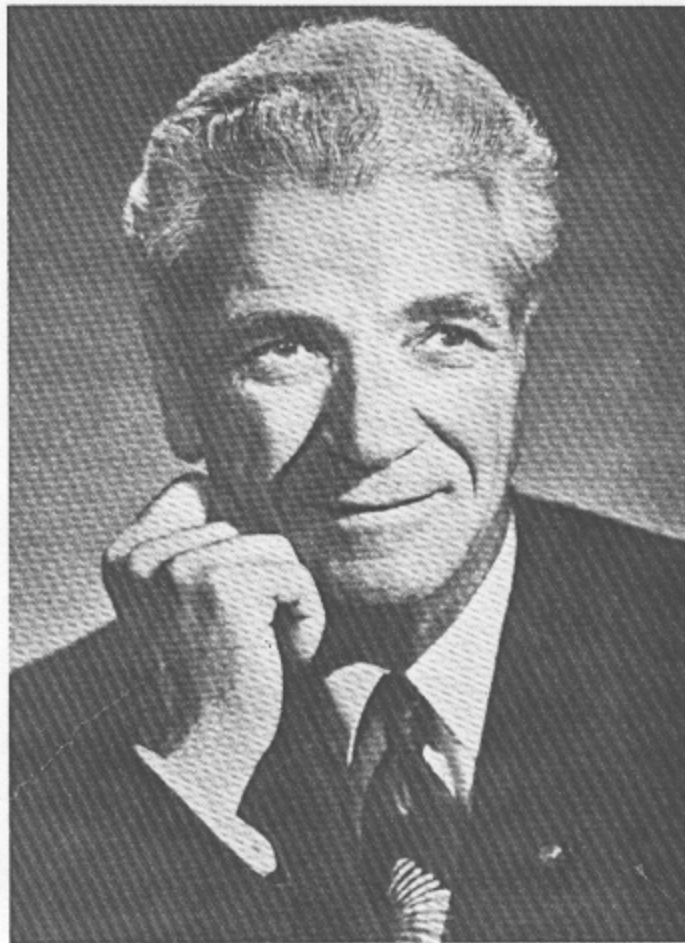
He first made news, however, after his experience on Nov. 20, 1952, near Desert Center, Calif. At that time he met a Venusian Scout Ship and its pilot. From that time on, his life was completely changed. With subsequent contacts and with increasing new knowledge, he felt that his responsibility was to reach the public with as much information as he could give them about the Space People and their mission to Earth.

He became world-famous as the author of several of the most-read books in the Flying Saucer field, plus many articles.

It was while Mr. Adamski was lecturing in the east that he contracted pneumonia. He died in a Washington, D. C. hospital. In accordance with his wishes, there was no funeral. As a veteran of World War I, his ashes were interred at Arlington National Cemetery, in Virginia.

Although he was a man of simple and humble origin, George Adamski became great in quiet, dignified service to his fellow man. He taught what he loved and knew best, giving generously of his time and energies to all who would listen. For he had learned that the Universe and all that it encompasses is an infinitely wonderful place, and that we are not alone in it.

He knew that the world was undergoing great change, and that the minds of men must expand to unprecedented new horizons in order to cope with world problems and to be receptive to their solutions --- in order to accept and to understand some of the "mysteries" of life and of the Universe, and our place in it.

" When I glanced back out, my initial reaction was that I was looking out into a complete star field, that the capsule had probably gone up while I was'nt looking out the window, and that I was looking into nothing but a new star field."

" But this wasn't the case, because a lot of the little things that I thought initially were stars were actually a bright yellowish - green, about the size and intensity as looking at a firefly on a real dark night."

" These little particles that were outside the capsule were, I would estimate, some six to ten feet apart, and there were literally thousands of them."

" As far as I could look off to each side I could see them, I could see them back along the path. Later on I turned around so that I was facing the direction from which they appeared to be coming, and although in that direction, toward the bright sunlight of the dawn, most of them disappeared. You still could see a few of them coming towards the capsule."

" I was coming very slowly through this field. I estimated that my velocity through this field was some three to five miles per hour. They did not appear to be emanating from the capsule. They appeared to have even distribution across each side of the capsule."

" There are numerous things that some of the people are thinking about and looking into, but I have no theory myself, except we observed them. We saw it on all three orbits about the same length of time."

disillusioned and disappointed. Could one say he was slightly schizophrenic? I don't know. I'm not a psychiatrist. But one often had the impression there were two people in that fine leonine body, the little Adamski, the burbler which always shoved its way to the foreground when the crowds gathered, talking non-stop and leaving your head spinning in a cloud of half-formed, badly expressed ideas. Then there was the Big Adamski, the man we came to know and love, who appeared only to his intimates, and once having appeared, left them in no doubt they had known a great soul. The Big Adamski spoke softly with a deep beautiful voice, incredibly old, wise and patient. Looking into those huge burning black eyes one realised that this Adamski knew and had experienced far more than he was able or willing to relate.

One of his intimates later told me, 'If George had been allowed to tell all he knew, his life would have been much easier for him. He'd have been able to prove his case.' However, there were certain extraordinary things he did describe to me in 1954, at a time before the Van Allen Radiation Belts had been discovered; and a long time before the first astronauts had circled the globe in a manbuilt space craft. Speaking of what he had seen and been told during his trip in a ufo, as claimed in his later book: 'Inside the Spaceships', he described:

- (1) the bands of radiation surrounding the earth in some detail. Some years later they were discovered and named 'The Van Allen Belts'.
- (2) the 'Fireflies' in space as sighted later by astronaut Glenn.
- (3) a curious phenomenon out beyond the stratosphere where he said the UFO entered a glowing patch of light. He had no explanation for this; merely stated he had observed it through the cabin window and wondered what it was.

This strange 'night airglow' phenomenon was later reported on several occasions by American astronauts. During the 'Gemini 6' flight, Schirra described it as 'the biggest surprise I had during the flight.' Cooper observed a similar glowing patch during the flight of 'Mercury 9'.

More recently, astronaut Cunningham in an attempt to confirm Cooper's sightings (which he said had been taken lightly) also noticed this curious glow. And Franklin Roach in the Condon Report (pages 193-194) gives a resume of these sightings.

(4) Until late 1969 it was firmly believed that the Asteroid Belt, that circle of dust, stones and asteroids orbiting the Sun between Jupiter and Mars was the remains of an exploded planet. Adamski, in 1954, insisted that this was not the case. His 'visitors' had told him that far from being a ruined world it was in fact a world in the making and would in time coalesce into a sphere, ultimately becoming an abode of future life. Only a few weeks ago astronomers came to the same conclusion; having worked out that if a planet exploded with sufficient force to shatter it into minute fragments, its remains would be flung far and wide and could never take the form of a slender ring with the Sun still at its centre. Adamski went even further and predicted a second asteroid belt between Neptune and Pluto. His 'visitors' spoke also of three more planets (as yet undiscovered,) far beyond Pluto, making twelve in all. Beyond these again lay a third asteroid belt: 'serving a dual purpose of blending space within our system with that of neighbouring systems'.

He has been proved correct concerning the nature of the first, and only known, asteroid belt. Perhaps the fantastic ten-year 'Billiard Ball' round-trip of all our planets planned for the late 1970's will vindicate him once again?

So the question has to be faced, how did a retired Californian living on Palomar Mountain know about these things in 1953, unless he had actually seen them for himself, or received advance information from astronauts? But in those days, the only astronauts were the presumed pilots of the UFOs, who, officially didn't exist.

Lucky guesses?

Adamski has made too many 'lucky guesses' for comfort.

Another thing he described to me were small remotely controlled observational disks (about two to three feet in diameter) which he said were sent out by the UFOs to collect data at low level. One evening as I was walking up the road to his house from Rincon Springs, I noticed a very bright ball of light rising rapidly from Adamski's roof, about a quarter of a mile away. It rose rapidly, rather like a silvery-gold Verrey Light, and continued to rise until it disappeared from sight. It gave the impression of accelerating as it rose. But the following evening I was to see it at very close range.

We were sitting on the patio in the twilight, George, Alice Wells, Lucy McGinnis, and I with my back turned facing the doorway. A curious cold feeling came over me as if of being watched, as if someone

WATCH THIS SPACE

Man's first attempt to communicate with another civilization deep in space began last week from the world's most powerful radio-telescope in Arecibo, Puerto Rico. The coded signal took only three minutes to transmit, but it will take 24,000 years to reach its destination, a star cluster called Messier 13 on the edge of the Milky Way. "None of us here will ever know if it worked," said Dr. Frank Drake, director of the astronomy centre at Arecibo.

The double-frequency signal gives scientific information about life on Earth and details of man's advancement, although the latter will be out of date by the time the signal arrives. Because Messier 13 is so far away, the telescope's beam will "hit" all the 300,000 stars making up the cluster. "At that distance, its size matches the size of the beam," said Dr. Drake. But will anyone hear the signal? "There is about a one in two chances of there being a civilization in Messier 13," says Dr. Carl Sagan, of Cornell University.

As your paper is noted for its controversial publications I chose Nation Review to commemorate the tenth anniversary of George Adamski's passing on April 24.

George Adamski, whose books and lectures in the '50s and early '60s have caused worldwide interest, has been called many things in those years and since — ranging from pioneer, prophet and science fiction writer to hamburger seller, charlatan and lunatic. To this day, one only needs to mention his name in public to unleash a vicious attack on his person and literature.

One cannot but ask why this should be so, why is there continued deliberate misrepresentation of Adamski's claims and statements and outright lies about him and his life?

The obvious answer is that what he disclosed about man, this world, the solar system and the universe represented a direct or indirect threat to every aspect of established order and every facet of vested interest on our planet. This was quickly realized by the stringpullers and guardians of the system and an aggressive opposition began to operate against the lone pioneer with the result, that a most urgent message to the inhabitants of the Earth was lost once again. Needless to say, that, apart from the ego-inflated status conscious academics, the agents of the opposition were greatly assisted by the lethargic masses who resent nothing more than being uprooted and torn out of a dreamlike existence where images reign supreme and the finer workings of cosmic reality are relegated to the realm of the unknowable unknown, beyond the threshold of life.

What was the content of the message which Adamski brought from the more advanced people from other worlds (this in itself an outrageous claim, say his detractors) and which so upset and disturbed the earthly psychological morons (high IQ or not) — as if anything could constitute a greater threat to their own survival than the misuse of the life sustaining substance itself?

Ever since John Glenn's and Scott Carpenter's comment on the firefly effect of particles in outer space which verified completely Adamski's earlier statements on this phenomenon, astronauts have been closely guarded on their return from space, and the pushbutton control in Houston has effectively prevented any tell-tale picture, sound or conversation to appear or be heard on the TV screens of the world.

Nevertheless, some secrets are inadvertently revealed and occasional "leaks" from scientific sources connected with the space program tell a very different story from the "findings" released for public consumption, in fact, they confirm the Adamski claims.

Individuals not easily misled will see George Adamski for what he really was: a man of rare courage and love for mankind who "stuck out his neck" — not unlike the trailblazers before him — and, predictably, he shared their lot. One day, when this mad, mad world will have come to its senses, it will recognize the true Space Age Pioneer.

LETTER TO A FRIEND

Samuel Taylor Coleridge, the English poet, critic and philosopher, was born October 21, 1772, at Ottery St. Mary in Devonshire, the tenth and youngest child of a clergyman and schoolmaster. He was precocious beyond compare, to say the least. At the age of three he could read a chapter in the Bible, and his interest in reading never subsided. Much of his character is explained in excerpts from a letter to a friend.

On October 16, 1797, Coleridge wrote:

"My father (who had so little of parental ambition in him, that he had destined his children to be blacksmiths, etc., and had accomplished his intention but for my mother's pride and spirit of aggrandizing her family) — my father had, however, resolved that I should be a parson. I read every book that came in my way without distinction, and my father was fond of me, and used to take me on his knee and hold long conversations with me. I remember that at eight years old I walked with him one winter evening from a farmer's house, a mile from Ottery, and he told me the names of the stars and how Jupiter was a thousand times larger than our world, and that the other twinkling stars were suns that had worlds rolling around them; and when I came home he showed me how they rolled round. I heard him with a profound delight and admiration, but without the least mixture of wonder or incredulity. For from my early reading of fairy tales and genii, etc., my mind had been habituated to the vast, and I never regarded my senses in any way as the criteria of my belief. I regulated all my creeds by my conceptions, not by my sight, even at that age" . . .

TRAVELLING IN SPACE

We do know that man is always seeking new outlets, new adventure, etc., and today he's even setting himself beyond the saucer question so that he thinks he will be travelling space and visiting other planets. To do that we have to find a method of operation. We do know that our oil is going to run out. We'll have to revert to something.

There's one thing we have to learn before we can make a successful flight to any planet even outside our own system, and that is we have to give up aerodynamics of the present day and go to a new line altogether. In aerodynamics we work on stresses, that sort of thing, and we have to build our ships accordingly. Yet in Nature, as far as Earth is concerned, there is no such thing.

The people who operate these space ships (and whether people believe it or not,

they ARE people like ourselves, and some of these days we are all going to see them) - have asked themselves at one time, a question that we should ask ourselves. You see, the Earth is revolving, steadily, at 18.5 miles per second. Yet we don't even realize we are moving. Not only is it moving in this orbit, it is also moving on a 24 hour basis up to 365 days, and in the meantime there is a wobble phase. It's operating then in three stages. Yet we know nothing about it, and we're living right on it. In other words, we are really riding a space ship - at 18.5 miles per second - and don't even think about it. "WHAT MAKES THIS EARTH MOVE!" They have asked themselves that question! No jet engine, as we call it. No wings on it. What makes it move?

They started investigating. Maybe we can build something - what we might call a satellite - that will operate in the same way, only man made. And they have succeeded in that. So there's really no mystery involved. About those turns they make, the Earth makes certain turns too. We don't

know a thing about it. Why? If the Earth was to stop turning this very moment, I doubt if any one of us would know what happened, because the air, what we call the atmosphere, would be gone. Just that fast - and we'd die from lack of air. And if it continued to stay standing still, then its energy within the Earth itself, would exert itself and start breaking the Earth up. It is just like a pilot, he goes up so high without a pressurized ship, and in lighter air he hasn't the support for his body from the outside any more, and he begins to expand. It is the same idea. So what they have really learned is this. They utilize these magnetic forces, - we call it magnetic force. In earlier days we called it static electricity. It produces our lightning.

We must admit that when there's lightning flashing for two or three hours steadily, like it does in California sometimes, very remarkably, all of our power plants hooked together could only produce one flash like that, and that would be the end of their power. Yet it goes on in the sky for hours. There's plenty of it there. They realize that. They have hooked onto that power. So they have power wherever they want to go. They have excess power at this point. They only use about ten per cent for propulsion. Ninety per cent they must dissipate. What do they do? They dissipate it from the skin of the ship, the surface. All particles in space are negative to space. Space is positive. So all particles that would hit the body of that ship are repelled by the negative radiation from the skin of the ship. There's a negative repulsion going on there, so the ship never touches anything, even a meteorite. What they have actually produced through this dissipation of the excess power, is an atmosphere around themselves, their own gravitational field - in a wavelength system.

If you drop a pebble in a still pool of water, you see wave after wave going out. If you can measure it correctly, you will find the ship is pressurized according to our law, at 14.7 inside, and that first wave radiating from the skin of the ship is also 14.7. When we see trails of these ships, and sometimes sparks flying behind, it is not

coming from the ship. Maybe that radiation is extending 50 miles, 100, or 200, miles away from the body of the ship, and it's out there, where the fringe of it is, that it comes in contact with the fringe of space itself, that we see the reaction.

So the ship is riding cool. Right on through. They don't even notice when they make a turn. I use this illustration as an explanation on that. You take an egg. Everybody knows about an egg. The yolk of an egg is the solid part. If you know the white of an egg, it is just like air would be around the Earth. The shell of the egg, the fringe of it produces a crust. If we were to put a man on the yolk, he is submerged on the yolk of an egg, he is submerged in the white of the egg, is he not? The friction and everything would be on the extreme part of the egg, which is the shell. Inside of the egg, the man then, wouldn't know a thing about it. That's really what they have done, - which the Earth is doing every day.

(The shape of the saucers). You see, they don't really have to make a turn. Their ball-type landing gears, as they have been called, are only used as landing gears in an emergency. They are actually condensers, for condensing static electricity. And we already know, in another way, that once you load a ball, a power ball, with static electricity, it is going to open up. So they are condensers. They can cut the power off one or the other. Whichever they cut off, that's the way the ship is going to go. They don't have to make a turn as we do, with our automobile or our ships, but they just swing this way or that way, and go. To us it looks as if they make a right angle turn, but they don't.

Captain Mantell got caught. He would never have got hurt had his ship been a fusilage type, alone without any wings. It works like two bars of metal with a magnet there. Because the two magnetic bars are both alike, they attract just like that. That's what would have happened. But the wing got caught and pulled in by this power they were radiating, repelling forth to pro-

fect their ship. Once the wing got caught the whole thing started breaking up. But if he had had a fuselage, like a cigar shape ship, both ships would have come together, just like the two bars do, and nothing would have happened. They can do that very easily.

They didn't mean to harm anybody. He just didn't know and he got in too close. It is just as when we used to hit the supersonic wall before we knew how to penetrate them. We didn't know any better. We didn't see it. That's what happened here. You see magnets radiate from the end, toward the center, — come all the way around. I question this, when they say that our Earth has north pole and south pole. I wonder if there's such a thing? One would be negative and the other would be positive, wouldn't it? That would be true according to our magnetic law. Yet we say the center of the Earth is positive — so both ends must be negative, instead of one positive and one negative, because the forces work this way. And suppose it would be possible, then one would be repelled by the positive sooner, yet both are pulled in. That's only theory, of course. . . . According to the magnetic law, positive repels positive and negative repels negative, and here's a positive coming toward the center and the center is positive. It couldn't be. It would be repelled there, but instead it is being attracted. So I'm wondering now, if both those ends are negative? That's where our fault is, — the trouble with a lot of things, maybe.

I believe our government deserves all the true information of a clear-cut nature that it is possible to give, because the better we are informed, the better we are prepared for anything that might come. So therefore a person has got to be very careful. It calls for a thorough investigation, from all angles. If it can get down to the basic core, you at least have some logical field in which the thing will explain itself. If you can't do that, then the thing is no good. . . .

Four of the top men in California on guided missiles interviewed me and asked me this question: "How can space ships go

through a cloud right after an atomic explosion and not be affected?" I said, "How am I to know?" "Well, we know you do know." "The only way a man would know would be if he was in one of those ships to know just what takes place. Do you mean that I have been in a ship and I should know?" "We know that you know." That's all they said. Well, then I told them just what the answer is, and they said it was good.

Then they asked me if I wouldn't become a consultant for the guided missile project. I said, "I'm no mechanic. I couldn't construct anything." Well, they said, "You don't need to be a mechanic. We've got men that can do anything that you tell them. All they want is your ideas." I said, "That calls for wages, doesn't it?" "Yes." "I don't want to become a wage earner for the government because if I did, then I couldn't talk as I'm talking now. I know that. I don't want to get tangled up like that, but I'll give any information that the government wants free — without charge, do it that way."

(Life on other planets).

Now, let's reason along the line of spectrum analysis. Spectrum is a wonderful thing, wonderful and dangerous. You can use it to actually know the weakness of iron, or of anything you might want to analyze. That's very good. But also, astronomers admit that space is full of so-called debris, — meteorites, particles of dust, and gas pockets of all sorts. Then, we can say there is 60 million miles between us and the planet Venus. We are going to register all of that debris before we hit the target. Since we don't know what percentages of interference there is between us and Venus, or any other body out there, how are we going to get a correct answer?

So you see, what they find could have registered anywhere between here and Venus. No matter how many times we try it we have the same problem. We will not know the truth until we have, — and I think we are working along that line, — what I call an electronic stick, that can go

out foot by foot into outer space and register each foot separately. When we have the exact percentages, then we can deduct all the interference that we hit prior to the target and then we can know what is actually on the planet. Our instruments are good so far as they go, but we know that even the 100 inch telescope down here (Palomar) only goes out one billion light years, and in a universe that has no beginning or ending, one billion light years is really nothing.

Let's get down to a common sense basis. A human being is a strange animal. He is made up of every element known on Earth, as well as in space for he breathes it. He would therefore, automatically be a potential for feelings, or vibrations, or frequencies that alert him to simple conditions from the lowest stage of mental action to the highest stage of intelligence. That would then call for a quite study of oneself, to be able to tell definitely, from what source he is getting his information.

The unfortunate part of astronomy today is that we sometimes ignore people who haven't had much education — excluding them totally from any important job. As an example, I once questioned the astronomers. "Gentlemen," I said, "the 48 inch telescope here on Mt. Palomar is endeavoring to make an atlas of the skies for the Geographic Society, something that has never been done. It has been in operation for quite some time now and it is not getting very far and yet this is the finest instrument ever made. Suppose a man came to you and laid out a map, an atlas of the sky. Well, what would you say?" "We'd say he was a genius." "But still you'd ask him where he got his education, now wouldn't you?" "Yes, we would do that." "Supposing he told you he couldn't write his own name, what would you say then?" "Well, we would be wasting our time. We would throw the map in the wastebasket." "That's what I thought you would say. Now let me say something without intending any harm. According to this statement, you have admitted right here that as a science, you are founded today on what is termed colossal ignorance." "What do you

mean by that?" one of them spoke up. "Isn't astronomy founded on the zodiac, — the ancient zodiac?" "Yes, it is." "Who constructed the ancient zodiac, according to history? It was the shepherders, living by night watching the sheep, having nothing to do, — they had no education, — the schooling system as we know it today, was unknown in that time. Yet they observed the sky so well that they marked out the constellations, and so on, — and to this day they have not been proven wrong. Astronomy is founded upon that. Yet today we go so far ahead of the natural laws that we condemn a man because he has no formal education and say that it would be impossible for him to get something like this." And that's about what the situation is today.

My discovery will prove Adamski's claim

In its September-October issue the **FLYING SAUCER REVIEW** printed an account of Mr. van den Berg's astonishing claim to have deciphered the Adamski hieroglyphics and to have constructed an anti-gravity device based upon them. The author now tells his own story and we append an interview with him by our correspondent, Mr. Phillip J. Human, on August 2.

THROUGH the medium of **FLYING SAUCER REVIEW** I take this opportunity of conveying to as many readers as possible throughout the world the facts of my findings through the past ten years, beginning in 1953, when one of the most controversial books ever on the subject of UFOs was published. I refer to *Flying Saucers Have Landed*, by Desmond Leslie and George Adamski, of America.

Many books have been written regarding UFOs or "flying saucers," but I can, through my own findings, in utmost sincerity, say that the most important of all books to be written are those by Mr. George Adamski. I say this because he has, in all sincerity and honesty, and with great courage, tried to convey to the world the simple straightforward truth about these phenomena.

I use the words sincerity and honesty quite openly as regards Mr. Adamski, since I now have indisputable proof for the scientist and layman alike that George Adamski's claims are authentic beyond reproach.

Careful judgment

I am not a person who believes in everything that I read without first weighing the pros and cons very carefully, and even then I reserve my judgment. I have learned through experience that it is unwise to judge my fellow beings without the necessary evidence to justify that judgment. Therefore, I did not judge Mr. Adamski off-hand as so many had done when I first read his book *Flying Saucers Have Landed*, since I had neither evidence nor proof that he was a fake, or that he was genuine.

Prior to my reading his book, my interest in flying saucers was nil, since I had never heard, or read, of them before. I was therefore in no position to take sides either for or against. What did arouse my interest was the amazing similarity between Mr. Adamski's photograph of a scoutship published in his book and a strange object that had trailed my bomber for three hours during the last war. This incident we reported to Intelligence on arrival at base, and subsequently learned that sightings of these strange phenomena had been reported before, but no explanation of what they were could be given.

On coming to the conclusion that there may be some connection between Adamski's story and my war-time sighting, I took a keen interest in the photograph of the symbolic message dropped to George Adamski by Venusians from just such a craft.

My opinion was, that if there was any truth in his book and there was a connection with my own sighting, then the symbols would give the answer, one way or the other.

From then on I worked for many months on the symbols, trying by every possible means to connect them in some way with a tangible solution. I finally succeeded in discovering the right "channel" through which the symbols could be interpreted. Here I was on my guard as to whether this was a clever hoax perpetrated by Mr. Adamski, or really symbols given to him by beings from another planet.

This gave me more reason to discover the truth, since I realised that either these symbols could be the basis for some of the greatest advancements in science in the world, or it could mean

a waste of time. I then wrote to Mr. Adamski and asked for clear prints of the symbols, since the reproduction in the book had lost most of the clarity and detail. On receipt of these prints I settled down to the arduous task of gleaming the information from them to the best of my ability—little realising the tremendous task that lay ahead. As the years passed by, more and more information was revealed—information that no being on earth could ever have dreamed up to use as a hoax, for they reveal the fantastic truth of these craft in detail. They reveal the method of propulsion, as well as two powerful magnetic motors, and detailed plans of the interior and exterior of these craft, giving both the large mother-ship and the smaller scout-craft commonly known as flying saucers.

Since the motors alone have not yet been invented on this earth, and since they have been solved through the symbolic message, the big question is: "Where does the message come

from?" Obviously not from anyone on this earth—that a child can see—so no matter how impressive the scientists may try to be, they cannot deny this, and are misleading the public.

Since these findings have borne practical proof of Mr. Adamski's genuineness and of space craft from planets other than ours, it is my intention, along with Mr. Adamski, to give to the people of the world that which is rightly theirs.

It is already too late for any interference from any source whatever, whether it be at Government level or not. This interference was foreseen years ago and consequently plans have in the past been put into operation and carried out in utmost secrecy throughout the world to counter any move seeking to prevent these works reaching mankind.

When the world has this proof, which is not far off now, Mr. Adamski will once and for all be vindicated.

My Interview with Basil van den Berg by Phillip J. Human

On the morning of April 29, 1962, another alleged contact with a being from another planet hit the headlines in a leading Afrikaans Sunday newspaper—*Stem*. In this instance the contactee was a Mr. Basil van den Berg, of Johannesburg. I have always been inclined to believe George Adamski, and as this latest contact was mainly based on the controversial Adamski "symbols," I was most keen to meet Mr. van den Berg personally. We started corresponding and I was impressed by his humility, sincerity and forthrightness. At length a mutually convenient time and date for our first meeting was agreed upon.

It is difficult to describe my feelings and thoughts as I walked down Eloff Street, Johannesburg, towards our rendezvous, on the morning of Thursday, August 2, 1962. As I approached a certain corner I noticed a tall man, erect, with kindly eyes, surveying the passing parade of shoppers. It was Basil van den Berg. I shook hands with the man whose contact story had caused such a sensation in South Africa and who claims to hold the magic formula that would ultimately pave our way to the stars.

We soon found a convenient tea room and sat down in a quiet spot. In my brief-case was a copy of the January-February *FLYING SAUCER REVIEW*, which describes Professor Marcel Honet's amazing discovery in northern Brazil of boulders with engraved symbols which bear a striking resemblance to those of Adamski. I noticed that my friend had brought a bulging folder and a strange gadget which he handed to me for inspection. It was part of a motor he had invented from the de-

coded Adamski symbols, and of which a photo appeared in the September-October review. It seemed to be made of steel, and I remarked about its weight and the fact that it seemed to be "alive." He smiled as he said "I'm glad you notice that it is alive. Look, here are the magnets!"

Then he described its importance in great detail and opened his files which testified to the enormous amount of work obviously involved in its construction. There were literally hundreds of triangular-like drawings that seemed to fit into a master blueprint. I nodded my head wisely and often, as if taking it all in, but at the same time pitied him, as the scientific jargon was falling on uncomprehending ears. "Basil," I thought, "you were never safer in your life. It doesn't mean a thing to me!"

He must have caught on as he suddenly asked: "Now what have you got in that magazine you said you were so keen to show me?"

I wondered what his reaction would be as I turned to Professor Honet's illustration of the Brazilian hieroglyphics. He seemed stunned for a moment and then exclaimed: "This is amazing! It is absolutely fantastic! The drawing is upside down, but just look at those symbols!" He then produced two prints of Adamski's symbols, and I noticed what a vast improvement they were on the one appearing in *Flying Saucers Have Landed*. He then compared Adamski's with Professor Honet's and excitedly drew my attention to numerous points of apparent similarity.

Our tea was cold by now, but that didn't matter. "Please give me this magazine for further

study under my magnifying glass," he pleaded.

"With pleasure," I replied. "but look at the time! We mustn't keep the *Stem* people waiting." They knew of my visit to Johannesburg and wished to interview us together.

As we hurried along to the *Stem* offices, Mr. van den Berg was explaining the three-dimensional aspect of the Adamski photograph and how he was discovering new symbols every time he studied them under a magnifying glass. "It seems there is no end to all the details given. What brilliant scientists these Venusians must be to be able to superimpose their symbols over Adamski's photograph." "You know," he went on, "I worked night and day to break down the code. Often I was tempted to call it quits, but yet I plodded on until I found success crowning my hard work. Soon I was constructing the motors. All the details were there. I shall never forget the day when the first motor was ready. It functioned perfectly. It was on my birthday. . . . Then I met the 'Master' . . ."

I did not press for details as we had reached the *Stem* offices. The hum of printing presses could be heard coming from the basement. I thought of the time, thirty years ago, when I worked in a printing office myself. In those days the offending flying saucers were virtually unknown.

In due course we were ushered into a spacious office. After the usual introductions I took my seat with a great deal of apprehension, but felt honoured all the same to take my stand in defence of the "saucers" and the beings who pilot them. But I need not have worried. I was in the company of sincere friends. They were "believers," too.

It was an interesting experience and the interview lasted nearly three hours. Once again Professor Homet was under discussion and my precious FLYING SAUCER REVIEW changed hands once more as it was needed to illustrate a report that subsequently appeared the following Sunday.

How I wished that every editor of every

national newspaper took such an interest in flying saucers in general, and FLYING SAUCER REVIEW in particular as did the *Stem* newspapermen!

I am happy to report that throughout the interview Mr. van den Berg backed my views and observations, and I was impressed by the obvious esteem in which this soft-spoken and unassuming "go-getter" was held by the *Stem* personnel.

Hours later I saw Mr. van den Berg to his bus, but not until he had told me more about his contacts. To put the reader in the picture also, I can do no better than to quote from one of his letters:

"A point I would like to clear at this stage is the misinterpretation by the editor of *Stem* regarding my meeting with our Brother. On the first occasion he merely put me back on to the right track of interpreting the symbols, since I had wavered and had become confused after five years, during which time the motor had already been completed. The second contact was brief, and merely confirmed the first. He brought no sketches of his own as reported, and gave me no help whatever in solving the symbols. I repeat: He merely pointed out the correct path to follow since I had deviated and had lost telepathic communication with the Master through my own emotions, and that was the sole purpose of the visit. Since then I have solved much more, and have gleaned a tremendous amount of knowledge through my own efforts. The Brother has taught me the folly of emotional interference and I have since guarded against it, thus keeping our telepathic channel open and clear.

"My aim is to prove to all and sundry Mr. Adamski's genuineness and that the symbols are *not of this world*. I could so easily claim these inventions as my own doing without even mentioning the symbols, and not a single soul on this planet would ever be the wiser. Not even Adamski!"

I believe Basil van den Berg just as I have always believed George Adamski.

UFO ABDUCTIONS AND THEIR VALIDITY

To investigate thoroughly any of the highly publicized UFO abductions and kidnappings, one must search recorded history.

One must analyze all possible UFO activity, from thousands of years to the present, that has occurred in China, India, and Africa, as well as North, Central and South America.

It is generally accepted that extraterrestrials have visited this planet. There are records in ancient China that indicate beings like us have visited China leaving behind some type of recording discs. These people were called the DRAPAS. They came to instruct and to teach, and not to abduct or kidnap.

Ancient myths from every known civilization are in agreement that beings of greater knowledge and wisdom have descended from the skies. These beings revealed the existence of a better way of life. Sometimes it was necessary to take Earthmen with them when they left and return them, some time later, with great knowledge of many things. Again, none of these stories describe any sort of hostility.

In the carefully recorded history of Tiahuanaco in the Andes, Stonehenge in England, Baalbek in Lebanon, Nasca in Peru, Egyptian and Mayan cultures, and Easter Island, we fail to find evidence of abductions against a person's will. Yet, all indicate UFO activity. Rather, the above-named places were sites of worship and gratitude toward the extraterrestrials who had shown earthmen how to construct, maintain and grow into a higher state of development.

Many theological authorities are now convinced that Biblical teachings were strongly influenced, if not directly inspired by extraterrestrial visitors. The Bible is filled with reports of angels who look exactly like men of earth, descending from "heaven" or space.

In Hebrews 3:2 it states: "Be not forgetful to entertain strangers, thereby some have entertained angels unaware." These "angels" seemed to be friendly. Logical analysis reveals that if these space-men look like us and can live here undetected, why would they abduct us and subject us to lengthy medical examination and the like, since we are no different in appearance than they? And surely, if we have been entertaining strangers unaware for over two thousand years of recorded history, those strangers certainly have had the opportunity to learn about the earthman's body long ago, should they have had the need or desire.

In Genesis 8:2 and 4, it states, "Sons of God took Earth Wives and had children with them", which proves that their physical and geometrical structures are very similar, if not identical, to ours. Ezekiel 1:13 to 28 reports of a friendly UFO landing and personal contact with four living creatures looking exactly like earthmen. These too, came to instruct and to guide, not to abduct.

If one continues to search carefully, one will find that each time men on earth get out of order, in one way or another, these messengers or spacemen have come down to Earth in their fiery cloud-like space ships, their wheels within wheels etc., and talked to the leaders or to some instruction to correct the situation. In some cases they were pretty firm. If the earth man didn't obey the instructions they took other actions. You may say the definition of "other action" could be called a hostility, however it would depend upon who

was the original aggressor. For example, it might have been that they intervened in order to stop aggression of one group of people against another, and it is possible that they may indeed have used force. Such acts, we term hostile, did happen throughout history, from time to time, for not all people coming from space are of a noble nature.

Yet even in these accounts, no mention of abductions and examinations and/or tortures have been recorded. Instances dating thousands of years show that upon occasion, visitations from space were accompanied by overwhelming displays of force and power. If the earth has been visited by both noble and the not-so-noble visitors for at least several thousand years, it would seem that one, it is a little late for them to want to examine and study us now, and two, with such awesome power as they seem to have possessed throughout history, what use would kidnapping one or two even a hundred earthmen have?

Early in 1965 I was informed by reliable sources, that several nations on the earth had managed to duplicate "flying saucers" similar to the ones which have been visiting the earth for thousands of years. Strangely, enough, ever since 1965 the hostile actions, abductions, forced medical examinations and such, have been widely reported. Since that time helpless 'victims' have reported being held captive by strange looking creatures, barely human-like, forced to undergo terrifying examinations and experiments in dimly lit space ships which emitted an evil sulphur smell. Could these 'contacts' with the terrifying extraterrestrials be in fact contacts with space crafts built on this earth by various governments, piloted by men of earth in strange costumes? But why, what could be the motive? Perhaps to scare, confuse and create fear in the public sub-conscious. A fearful people are easier to control.

Let's go back again to ancient historical records of visitations. Such contacts were almost always with 'angels', and the word angel not only meant someone very good and noble but beautiful as well, yet today, all the contacts are deformed creatures with many eyes, arms, legs, and fingers, as one can imagine. If all the recorded visitations are to be believed, these "angels" would have had little use in kidnapping us and returning to their planet. We of earth, for the most part, have never been able to live in peace with one another, and since one rotten apple can spoil the whole basket, what could we offer a society that has learned to live without aggression and war?

In the British book, *Alternative-003*, the authors reveal from NASA contacts, that the U.S.A. and U.S.S.R. have had bases on our moon since the late 1960's. The very well informed authors of a British BBC Broadcasting crew state that many recent kidnappings of scientists, their relatives, and often whole bus loads of young people are the acts of our UFO people trying to supply their top secret bases with cheap laborers. Could this be possible?

There may be another explanation. Some years ago, I heard of 28 people who disappeared from a chartered boat off the Florida coast. These 28 people all had one thing in common, they were of extraterrestrial origin. According to my information, after traveling from different places around the world, they arrived in Miami to await their pick-up at sea.

When the mother craft came for them they must have been in a hurry, for they left in the middle of their meals. Pilots of aircraft have vanished like that too, sometimes with the aircraft and sometimes the jets were returned to their home airports and landed safely, yet no one was in the pilot's seat. To make the story more interesting, the planes were returned, sometimes several hours after they should have run out of fuel. Examination showed that the fuel tanks were indeed empty, as they should have been.

I should feel that many of today's UFO missions to earth carry the same message as those of Biblical days—except at that time we did not have the well organized opposition toward them as we have today.

Life has become increasingly complicated both economically and politically, and there exists great panic amongst those in power. All technical, economical, and spiritual progress is under their positive control.

Several officials of a Government once told me, "Our government knows the extraterrestrials are here, and that they are good for us, but we don't want them." When I asked why, I was told "because of political, economic and religious reasons."

According to a recent article published by the *Blade Tribune* in Oceanside, California, a Mexican farmer was given the secret by a spaceman of how to grow giant vegetables. Cabbage 40 lbs., onions 9 lbs. etc. The government came with 20 experts to check out the story. Experimental neutral acreage was used by these experts. They used fertilizer and produced 30 tons of produce per acre. The farmers who had been contacted and given this secret of high production, produced 106 tons, without the use of fertilizers.

He complained later that the government thanked him for the demonstration but did not ask how he had done it. They did not want to know. However, the question arises, aren't there lots of hungry people in the world? They could all be fed with little land and little effort, should they apply this farmer's methods, which he received from the extraterrestrials. One can only wonder why a government would not want progress and betterment for its people.

With the ever-increasing volume of documented sightings over the past 25 years, there is little denying that we have been, and are being, visited by people from other planets. The old angle of official denial can no longer satisfy the majority of the people so a new approach is in order. We know that the masses can be best controlled through fear and terror of the unknown; this is the greatest weapon any man can wield over another. Could the rash of sightings involving abductions, and fears be nothing but an act of self-defense by the few who hold power over the many, the few who felt threatened by the coming of the space visitors and their growing acceptance? □



UFO UPDATE

To date, more than 200 UFO crashes have been reported over the span of 30 years. But only a fraction or about 2% of those crashes have been actual extraterrestrial spacecraft.

Ninety-eight per cent of the crashes occurred with our earth built, duplicate magnetic flying discs, built by some of the worlds top governments.

Our scientist were intrigued by the extra terrestrial technology and after 2 ships crashed near White Sands, New Mexico, duplication of construction and propulsion was attempted and by 1966 achieved.

Much needed to be learned about magnetic propulsion, construction of parts and positive flight control of devices operating on a complete new concept of flight. In its infancy naturally, crashes and casualties often occur, as with new designs in conventional aircraft.

It is foolish to believe that those visitors from other worlds, in our system and beyond, would come to visit earth to commit suicide by not being technologically prepared for our aggression, causing countless spacecraft to crash.

It just doesn't make sense. A civilization which has mastered magnetic flight since before Biblical times, had to have their craft first thoroughly tested in their atmosphere before they attempted and finally mastered interplanetary flight.

Thus, witnesses observing a secret landing or a crash of an Earth built UFO would have no idea of the origin of the craft. After reporting the incident and being interrogated, the witnesses often are so confused that they are no longer sure of details and their reports are sketchy and unclear.

With this in mind it must be acknowledged that several true extraterrestrial spacecraft crashes have occurred over the past years.

Two bell shaped UFO's came too close to the radiation cloud of an atomic bomb explosion at White Sands, New Mexico during the late 1940's. Radiation entered the climate control system through its rotating power coils and burned the crew. These 2 craft and the bodies inside were reportedly removed by the Air Force to Wright Paterson Air Force Base, in Dayton Ohio.

Another incident happened during the early 1960's when a Mothership had released its scoutcraft to observe joint Naval maneuvers over the Pacific. One scoutcraft hovered over a destroyer and a missile was shot through its bottom and top observation lens, which resulted in a crash of this craft into the Pacific. After this occurrence the large carrier craft gathered up the remaining scoutcraft and vanished. You will note, there was NO RETALIATION upon the part of the occupants of the spacecraft!!

Several other reports from Europe and South Africa, indicate Laser Technology aided in crippling some of the extraterrestrial spacecraft which resulted in loss of control and ultimate crash.

It is also important to note, the 4 to 5 foot occupants of these many crashed crafts which have been reported as having no face, gray - blue skin tone, no hair, oversized heads, etc. are NOT Human occupants but rather androids. Robot like creations designed to function for about six months on a single charge. These are sent forth to explore the more dangerous territories where human life might be endangered.

The three fingered hands are really claw like nails designed to hold on to objects and can be used in self defense if they are so programmed. These androids are able to operate in space between the walls of the spacecraft where high radiation propulsion units need to be serviced. They are also highly suited for exploring planets with unfavorable atmospheric environments without the need for space suits or air support systems.

It is believed, we too, are duplicating these type of androids and one can only wonder as to what we may be programming them for.

Today, it has become extremely difficult to distinguish the difference between their craft and ones of our own making based solely upon a sighting. George Adamski told me many years ago, the organized opposition had a definite plan to confuse the

public about the entire space matter by making use of people who have little or no experience of their own. When people speak of others experiences they can easily be confused. Since Adamski left this planet in 1963, we have had many such individuals and governments who have succeeded in keeping the real truth from the public. Today confusion prevails and people are benefiting little from the teachings of the space visitors.

Water Geysers Found On Moon

HOUSTON (UPI) — Water clouds have been detected erupting like geysers through cracks on the lunar surface — a discovery that could lead to a permanent U. S. manned moon base, a Rice University scientist said Friday.

It was the first time water has been discovered on the moon, which long has been thought by scientists to be a dry, barren sphere.

The vapor was discovered by two instruments called "suprathermal ion detectors" which were left on the lunar

surface by the astronauts aboard the Apollo 12 and 14 missions.

The scientist, Dr. John W. Freeman Jr., 36, said the instruments detected a "moon geyser" last March 7 which lasted about 14 hours. He said the cloud — 99 per cent water vapor — spread to cover an area of more than 10 square miles near the Apollo instruments on the eastern edge of the moon's Ocean of Storms.

"This indicates there is possibly liquid water in the subsurface of the moon," Freeman said.

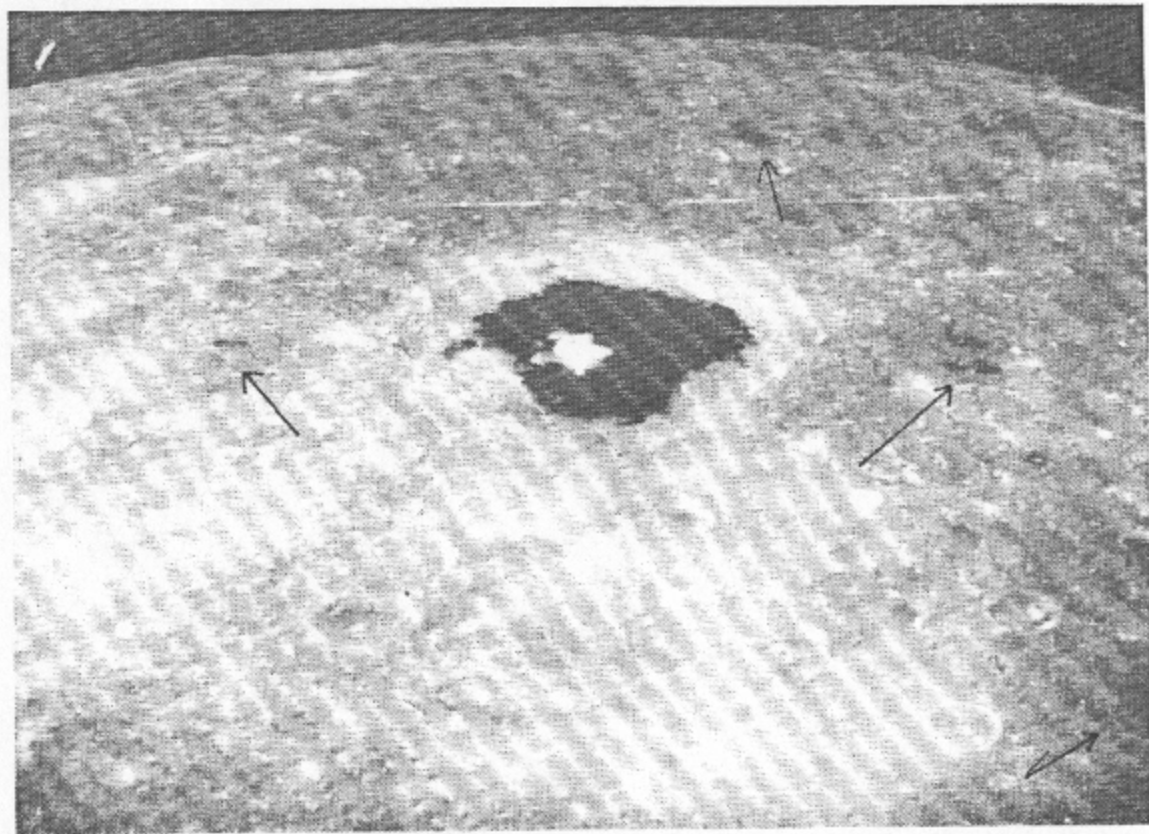

SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT.

Did you know that the well-known author, Jonathan Swift, (Gulliver's Travel's) gave an exact description of the two moons of the planet Mars over one hundred years before they were discovered by the American Astronomer, Asaph Hall, in 1877?

And that Swift described in exact details the sizes, speeds, and distances of the, by now, well-known two Moons of Mars , Phobos and Deimos? How could he have done so, unless he was really taken up there by the Martians in a space craft, which Swift called in 1726, a "city in the sky?"

Did you know that the National Aeronautic and Space Administration, the Academy of Science, both Soviet and American, and a tremendous number of world - renowned astro-physicists and astronomers are convinced that LIFE exists on Mars, Venus, and even the larger planets, Jupiter and Saturn, including their satellites? Here is proof.....

In 1959 Dr. Shklovsky, a top Soviet planetary physicist, announced, after his careful studies of the two moons of Mars, that they both are, in reality, space vehicles: artificial satellites constructed of aluminum and magnesium, and are hollow inside. Dr. Shklovsky's findings are based on these facts.....

Phobos orbits 3 times as fast as Mars rotates on its own axis, which is unnatural, and both moons reflect light as it would come from an aluminum surface according to spectroscopic-prism analysis. Aluminum is a metal which does not exist, in a natural state anywhere. Highly advanced, metallurgical science is very much necessary to produce aluminum.

Both moons are too small and too close to the surface of Mars to be of natural origin, between five and ten thousand miles.

Did you know, that the American astronomer Dr. H.M. Sinton of Yerkes Observatory in Wisconsin, told the National Academy of Science: "Phobos and Deimos may well be large orbiting cities, filled with men, women and children?"

And another such space station was discovered by Dr. William H. Pickering of Harvard. It was mysterious discovery of the outer-most known moons of planet Saturn, and it was going, or orbiting, in the "wrong" direction, as no natural satellite does. It is fact that all natural satellites orbit in a counter-clockwise direction. Later the mysterious space station disappeared for about sixty-three years, and now in 1966 was rediscovered in an entirely different position and distance from planet Saturn, from what Dr. Pickering reported in 1904.

The same applies for the decades of innumerable reports, by leading professional and amateur astronomers, of unnatural moving lights, bridges which suddenly appear and after a few weeks vanish, and glowing, pulsating objects, moving at high speeds within the craters and valleys of our Moon. Often traveling a thousand miles across the Lunar surface within a few minutes, then landing or hovering in certain craters like "Plato, Cassendi, Grimaldi"ect. and again moving at terrific speeds somewhere else on the Lunar surface.

The late British Royal Astronomer Percival Wilkins, like many others, has published a full report on these "happenings" on and above the Lunar surface in his world famous book "Our Moon".

And how do our Governments react to the fact that the Earth is being visited by highly advanced, noble human beings from the many inhabited planets of our solar sys-

tem and beyond? What is the reaction of our leaders regarding these facts?

Here are some excerpts from some of our present laws, which may be the underlying cause for much of the doubletalk, which seems to come from our Governments from time to time.

A.F.R. - 200 - 2, issued on August 26, 1953 by the then Secretary of the Air Force, Harold E. Talbott. Under paragraph 9, called, "Release of Facts" it was provided that only hoaxes, practical jokes and erroneous U.F.O. reports can be given to the public or press. 'All genuine UFO reports received By The Air Force Must Be Kept From The Public.'

Under A.F.R. 200 - 2 all confirmed Flying Saucer reports must be rushed to Intelligence by teletype or radio. When possible all tangible evidence must be flown immediately to ATIC (Air Force Technical Intelligence Center at Wright Patterson Airforce Base in Dayton, Ohio.)

1. Parts of flying Saucers, actual or suspected.
2. Photos of radar scopes, showing saucer maneuvers and speeds.
3. Genuine pictures of flying saucers.

A.F.R. - 200 - 2 confines actual UFO investigation to three super-secret groups.

The Directorate of the Air Force Intelligence at the Pentagon; the 4602 d Air Intelligence Service Squadron, which has special investigators at all Air Defense bases; The ATIC at Dayton, Ohio.

Even top ranking Air Force officers are warned not to probe beyond the first stage - that of securing UFO reports from these three groups.

* * * * *

JANAP. 146 (B) issued September 1951 and declassified per D A Message dated December 12, 1953. (JANAP means Joint Army - Navy - Air - Publication.) Under section III any pilot who reveals an official U.F.O. report can be imprisoned for one to ten years and fined up to \$10,000.00 (Title 18, U.S. Code, 793).

A second order carries court-martial penalties.

Under a subhead "CIRVIS", JANAP 146 orders pilots to report by radio U.F.O. reports from any spot in the world. By the security clause, however anyone who makes a CIRVIS report - or learns what one contains - is forbidden even to reveal its existence. This order, backed by fines and imprisonment, applies to military, naval and airline pilots making CIRVIS reports on U.F.O's.

* * * * *

PRNC. 3020. 1 Code 03 issued July 23, 1954 by the Potomac River Naval Command. Signed by Admiral T.B. Hill, this directive ordered immediate reporting of unidentified flying objects. It used the code word "FLY OBJECT" in phoning or teletyping reports. They were to be send to the following:

1. Director of A.F.I.
2. A.T.I.C.
3. C.O. - A.F.C.

4. C.O. EASTERN A.D.C.
5. Director of Naval Intelligence
6. C.O. EASTERN Sea Frontier
7. Commandant, Potomac River Naval Command

To insure secrecy on the reports, it also cited JANAP 146, A. F. R. 200 - 2 and two previous Navy orders, OPNAV 3820 and Directive 3820. 2 by the Commander of the Eastern Sea Frontier.

On February 5, 1958 new instructions to insure secrecy on UFO developments were issued to all Air-Force Commands.

The orders are contained in a revised seven page edition of A. F. Regulation 200 - 2, the official " Bible " on U. F. O's.

It says page 4, paragraph 9:

Information regarding a sighting may be released to the press or general public by the Commander of the Air Base concerned **ONLY IF IT HAS BEEN POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED AS A FAMILIAR OR KNOWN OBJECT.**

The Air Force has another U. F. O. censorship memorandum, No. 200 - 9. It is classified and details are not yet known as to its contents.

Ask and write your Congressmen if they know of these orders. Since these orders in no way seem to involve the security of our nation, why were they made in the first place? And why are they allowed to remain in force? Ask them to make a thorough investigation into this matter, and than to act in behalf of you, the people, whom they represent throughout our nation, and who as taxpayers are entitled to know what is going on.

UFOs Watch Every Move NASA Makes, Say Astronauts Who Were Tailed on Space Shot

Unidentified flying objects continue to haunt and puzzle America's spacemen. The National Aeronautics and Space Administration admits that, in addition to 20 other U.S. spacemen, the astronauts of Skylabs II and III were the latest of our space missions to sight UFOs.

Owen Garriott and Alan Bean, watched and photographed a mysterious red object for 10 minutes before it disappeared.

Later, Edward Gibson of Skylab III reported to Mission Control at Houston that he and his companions, Gerald Carr and William Pogue, were being chased by "little red lights."

"The men of Skylabs II and III definitely did see UFOs. That is, we don't know what it is they saw and photographed," said Dennis Williams, a public relations spokesman for Mission Control, in a TATTLER interview.

According to at least one prominent UFO expert, George D. Fawcett of Mt. Airy, N.C., these latest two episodes bring to at least 20 the number of UFOs seen or photographed by American and Russian spacemen.

These include the experiences of astronauts aboard the Apollo 11 mission:

During that mission, Neil Armstrong, Edwin Aldrin and Michael Collins reported being followed for two days by a UFO which didn't leave until they were approximately halfway to the moon.

Although the Skylab III astronauts photographed the mysterious red lights that followed them, Williams told TATTLER that no further details about the sighting will be available for the present time.

There are, however, considerably more details available about the sighting by Skylab II of the glowing red object against the black curtain of space some 270 miles above the earth.

Bob Gordon, another Mission Control spokesman, told TATTLER that the men of Skylab II did indeed see a UFO and that they also photographed it.

According to Garriott:

"Jack (Lousma) first noticed this rather large red star out of the wardrobe window. Upon close examination, it was much brighter than Jupiter or any of the other planets.

"It had a reddish hue to it, even though it was well above the horizon. We observed it for about 10 minutes prior to sunset. It was slowly rotating because it had a variation in brightness with a 10-second period.

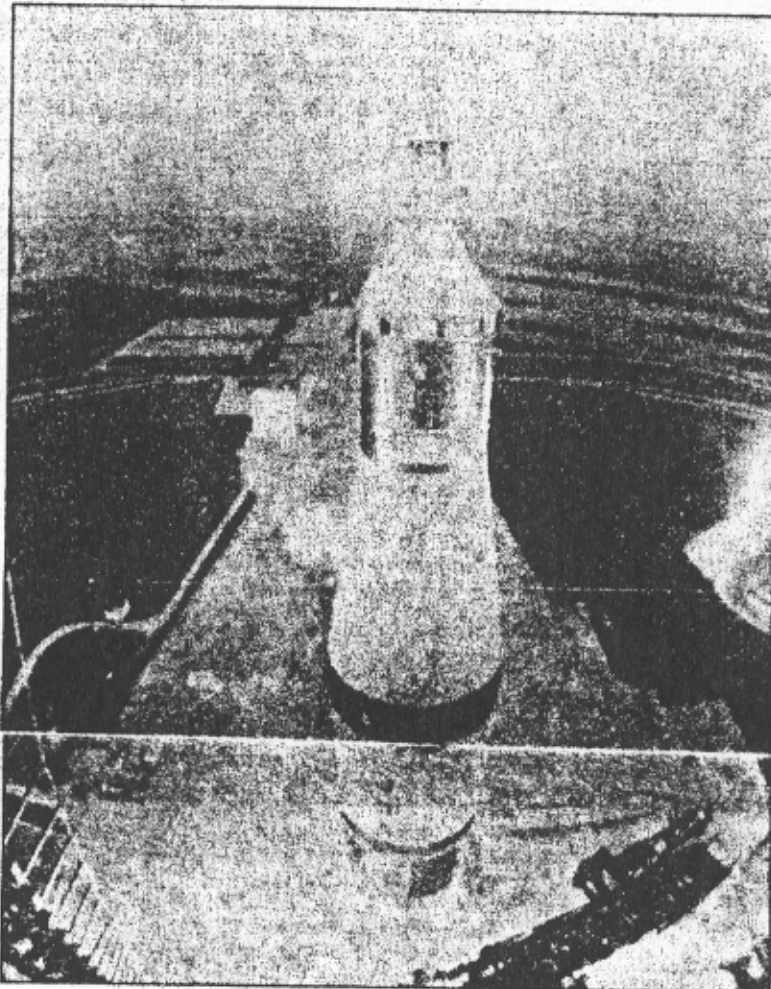
"We went into darkness about five seconds later. From the 5 to 10 second delay in its disappearance, we surmised that it was no more than 30 to 50 nautical miles from our location," said Garriott.

"From its original position in the wardrobe window, it did not move more than 10 or 20 degrees over the next 10 minutes we watched it. Its orbit was very close to our own.

"We never saw it on any earlier or on any succeeding orbits," he concluded.

GORDON SAID no effort was made to determine what the Skylab II astronauts had seen, even though the North American Air Defense Command (NORAD) did not have the object on their screens.

"It was just something up there. It could

have been any one of thousands of objects up there. No one was especially excited about it," he said.

Dr. J. Allen Hynek of Northwestern University, a consultant to the Air Force on its now-defunct UFO research effort, Project Blue Book, and the foremost authority on UFOs, told TATTLER:

"The Skylab II sighting certainly qualifies as a UFO, since no one is able to explain it satisfactorily.

"If it was space junk or the booster rocket for Skylab I, it's strange that NORAD didn't have it on tracking. They track every damned thing - even at that height.

"I understand that NASA has a lot to do and can't check out every thing unusual that is reported, but it could be that something like this object might be the key to our learning just what genuine UFOs are," he said.

According to Fawcett, American astronauts and Russian cosmonauts have been seeing UFOs ever since man started his efforts to step into space more than 10 years ago.

The first of these date back to Feb. 20, 1962, when John Glenn, piloting his Mercury capsule, saw three objects following him and then overtake him at varying speeds.

FAWCETT SAID other sightings, according to his records, include:

May 24, 1962 - Mercury VII - Scott Carpenter reported photographing firefly-like objects with a hand camera and that he had what looked like a good shot of a saucer.

May 30, 1962 - X15 pilot Joe Walton photographed five disc-like objects.

July 17, 1962 - X15 pilot Bob White photographed objects about 30 feet away from his craft and about 56 miles up.

Oct. 3, 1962 - Mercury VIII - Walter Shurra reported large glowing masses over the Indian Ocean.

May 16, 1963 - Mercury IX - Gordon Cooper reported a greenish UFO with a red tail during his 15th orbit. He also reported other mysterious sightings over South America and Australia. The object he sighted over Perth, Australia, was caught on screens by ground tracking stations.

Oct. 12, 1964 - Voskhod 1 - Three Russian cosmonauts reported they were surrounded by a formation of swiftly moving disc-shaped objects.

March 8, 1964 - Voskhod 2 - Russian cosmonauts reported unidentified object just as they entered the earth's atmosphere.

June 3, 1965 - Gemini IV - Jim McDivitt reported he photographed several strange

objects, including a cylindrical object with arms sticking out and an egg-shaped UFO with some sort of exhaust.

Dec. 4, 1965 - Gemini VIII - Frank Borman and Jim Lovell photographed twin oval-shaped UFOs with glowing undersides.

July 18, 1966 - Gemini X - John Young and Mike Collins saw a large cylindrical object accompanied by two smaller, bright objects, which Young photographed. NASA failed to pick them up on screens.

Sept. 12, 1966 - Gemini XI - Richard Gordon and Charles Conrad reported a yellow-orange UFO about six miles away. It dropped down in front of them and then disappeared when they tried to photograph it.

Nov. 11, 1966 - Gemini XII - Jim Lovell and Edwin Aldrin saw four UFOs linked in a row. Both spacemen said they were not stars.

Dec. 21, 1968 - Apollo 8 - Frank Borman and Jim Lovell reported a "bogey" - an unidentified object - 10 miles up.

July 16, 1969 - Apollo 11 - This was the mission on which a UFO chased the space craft.

Scientists Reveal . . .

Alien UFOs Watched Our First Astronauts on Moon

The first men on the moon weren't there alone!

Two alien spaceships landed near Apollo 11 and watched as our astronauts stepped onto the dusty surface, reveal U.S. and Soviet scientists in a stunning disclosure.

The astronauts saw the UFOs and even photographed them, The ENQUIRER has learned — but the stupefying close encounter has been kept completely under wraps by NASA until now.

A former top consultant to NASA has admitted the mind-boggling event took place during the historic mission — and was covered up.

"When the (Apollo 11) module landed at the bottom of a crater, two alien spacecraft appeared at the crater rim," revealed scientist Maurice Chatelain, formerly under contract to NASA.

"The encounter was common knowledge in NASA. But nobody has talked about it until now."

Incredibly, NASA's cover-up was so massive that the news has taken 10 years to reach the American public — and had to be first disclosed by Soviet scientists, who found out about it two years ago.

"I am absolutely certain this episode took place," said Dr. Vladimir Azhazha, a physicist and professor of mathematics at Moscow University.

"According to our information, the encounter was reported immediately after the landing of the module.

"Neil Armstrong relayed the message to Mission Control that two large, mysterious objects were watching them after having landed near the moon module. But his message was never heard by the public — because NASA censored it."

Buzz Aldrin even took moving pictures in color of the UFOs from inside the module — and continued shooting after he and Armstrong went outside, according to another Soviet space scientist, Prof. Aleksandr Kazantsev.

Dr. Azhazha says that the UFOs flew away just minutes after the astronauts came out on the moon's surface. Aldrin later carried his incredible movie back to earth — where NASA immediately put it under wraps, the professor charged.

Dr. Azhazha — aware that his telephone interview with The ENQUIRER was being monitored by Soviet security agents — refused to identify the source of his information. But he and other Russian space experts say the encounter has been common knowledge among Soviet scientific circles for the past two years.

A third Russian space scientist, Dr. Sergei Bozhich, is

lectures at Moscow University.

"Two spaceships probably were dispatched so there would be backup in an emergency. Undoubtedly their objective was to learn what they could about the extent of earth's latest technological know-how.

"Having verified the landing, they departed without making contact."

Alien spacecraft apparently were tailing Apollo 11 long before it set down on the moon. Chatelain revealed:

"On the third day of the mission, a strange object was spotted in the distance. But its dimensions or even its shape were practically impossible to determine. To Armstrong it looked like interconnecting rings, Collins said it was a hollow cylinder and Aldrin thought it looked like a huge, half-open book.

"The mystery object finally disappeared and the astronauts never knew what they had seen."

Another "strange incident"

convinced that the two alien ships were sent to spy on Armstrong, Aldrin and Michael Collins during their history-making 1969 mission.

"It's my opinion that other civilizations learned of the proposed moon landing by picking up radio signals from earth," said Dr. Bozhich, who

occurred when Apollo 11 neared the moon, added Chatelain, who now is retired.

"The astronauts suddenly heard strange noises on the radio — noises similar to a train whistle, fire engine siren or power saw," he disclosed. "These sounds were thought to be some form of code."

But the real shocker came when Armstrong and Aldrin landed, Chatelain said. Two UFOs also landed — and Aldrin photographed them.

Apollo 11's radio transmissions to Mission Control were interrupted on several occasions without explanation, according to Chatelain. He's certain this was done to hide the news of the UFO encounter from the public.

Chatelain added:

"The pictures have never been published . . . NASA did not release them. There were certainly alien beings there — but the official record is silent about it."

NASA spokesman John McLeaish denied that the agency censored any voice transmissions from Apollo 11's astronauts, or any film shot by them. He admitted, however, that a slight delay in transmission took place — but said it was due simply to processing through electronic equipment.

The Apollo 11 flight wasn't the only one that encountered UFOs, according to Dr. Azhazha. He said Apollos 12, 13 and 16 also spotted spacecraft.

American UFO experts say they have heard about the shocking Apollo encounters, too — from people in a position to know.

Leonard Stringfield, author and board member of the

Mutual Unidentified Flying Object Network (MUFON), said a government scientist told him about the Apollo 11 incident last summer.

And John Schuessler, deputy director of MUFON, told The ENQUIRER: "I work with astronauts at NASA and have heard the story from them."

UFO researcher and author Tim Beckley — who says he's seen official NASA photos of cone-shaped UFOs on the moon — feels the government is suppressing the truth to save face.

"The government is not going to admit we're defenseless against beings from another planet," he explained.

Joseph Goodavage, another noted author and UFO expert, says he's learned straight from secret NASA files that alien spacecraft were regularly spotted by the Apollo astronauts. "There's no question that something is going on up there," he declared.

The astronauts have kept silent about their UFO encounters because they are trained to believe it's a matter of national security, said Dr. Fred Bell, a scientist and former consultant to NASA.

"I've seen photographs of UFOs taken by astronauts — but when questioned, the astronauts refused to talk about them," said Dr. Bell. "The lid has really been clamped down on this."

Added Stringfield: "If the government released one little bit of what happened on the moon, it would be the story of the century."

ASTRONAUT PHOTOGRAPHS UFO

COLONEL GLENN SIGHTS UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECTS WHILE IN ORBIT:

On his history-making trip through space last February 20th, Col. John Glenn saw a great number of small glowing objects which have been described loosely as "fireflies." Here is the story in Glenn's own words:

"At the first light of sunrise - the first sunrise I came to, I was still facing back toward the direction which I had come from with normal orbit altitude, and just as the first rays of the sun came up onto the capsule, I glanced back down inside to check something, and when I glanced back out, my initial reaction was that I was looking into a star field...These little things that I thought (at first) to be stars were actually a bright bluish green, about the size and intensity of a firefly on a really dark night. These little particles were about 6 to 10 feet apart, and there were literally thousands of them. As far as I could look off to each side I could see them, and I could also see them back along the path. Later on I turned around so that I was facing the direction from which they appeared to be coming; and although, in that direction, toward the bright sunlight of the dawn most of them disappeared, you still could see a few of them coming toward the capsule. I was moving very slowly through this field. I estimated that my velocity through the field was some 3 to 5 miles per hour. The particles did not seem to be emanating from the capsule. They appeared to have an even distribution on each side of the capsule....I saw them for a period of $3\frac{1}{2}$ to 4 minutes....They varied in size from about pinhead size to about three-eighths of an inch in diameter....I observed them on all three orbits, for about the same length of time at each sunrise...."

What did Glenn actually see? Several theories have been considered, but none have been proven. The "fireflies" could not likely be the controversial copper needles sent into space by the United States some time ago. These are now known to be in a different orbit, and are bunched up in five or six useless clumps, i. e., the experiment was a failure. It has been suggested that Col. Glenn saw "spots before his eyes," caused by coming into the bright dawn suddenly out of the darkness. This is an absurd notion, in our opinion; Certainly, in his three years of intensive psychological, physical and mental training, Glenn was taught to distinguish between physical objects and visual illusions. The most likely theory advanced to date is that the astronaut saw frozen droplets ejected into the frigidity of space from a cooling device on his spacecraft. Yet, even this explanation does not suffice. During a visit to the Pentagon last March, we were told that the objects, some of which were as large as an inch in size, still have not been identified.

Another very interesting phenomenon from the Glenn flight is shown in the photo at the top of the next page. This picture, taken from the Los Angeles Times of February 22nd, bears the following caption: "Mystery streaks: Unexplained streaks, apparently of light, appear on picture taken by John Glenn with hand-held camera as he whirled through space...."

Quite amazingly, Col. Glenn's experience tends to confirm the claims of the late George Adamski, made in his book, INSIDE THE SPACE SHIPS, published in 1955. In that book, he described saucer flights he made with the space people. In one passage he used the word "fireflies" to describe a phenomenon he alleges to have seen. Adamski's followers also claim that statements he made about the moon have been proven by recent NASA photographs -- JWM.

Of all the people in the flying saucer world, George Adamski stands alone as its most controversial character. Many others have claimed contacts and been treated with tolerance, belief or amused contempt, but George had only to open his mouth to bring down a storm of abuse, praise and wonderment.

Perhaps I came to know him as well as anybody, I stayed with him several times and discovered facets in his character seldom revealed in public. Underneath the talkative, colorful exterior lurked a very great human being. Some quirk in his nature often took pains to conceal this and present instead, as his public face, a far more shallow person than he really was.

Who was he? Certainly no ordinary person. Physically he was Polish with, I think a touch of Romany. Immensely strong, good looking and with burning black eyes. Spiritually he was more than one person. There was the George of public lectures — the one I liked least for he tried to say too much all at once. Then there was the relaxed, naughty George with a keen eye for a pretty face, and a pluckish delight in shocking the professed and prudish.

Then there was another George, beautifully spoken, wise, kind, and deeply aware of the importance of his task. Through this George, I several times glimpsed the presence of a Master, and I was always sorry when the curtain came down again and the worldly mask obscured him.

I often wondered why he should have been singled out as the prime prophet of saucery. He believed that he had reincarnated from another planet through karmic reasons to give his teachings, and I find that idea quite acceptable. He believed that others, greater in the world's esteem, had also been contacted and given the same mission, but that for various personal reasons had refused or failed. He saw himself as the 'lame the halt and the blind' who were called to the King's feast after the chosen guests had made excuses not to come. He felt he was a broken reed, but alas the only reed willing to try and play their tune. So with all his might, with his inability to write and speak good English, and the innate difficulties of being the character that he was, he set out undaunted by criticism or abuse to give the message as best he saw it.

This to me seems most probable, even a wise move on the part of the Brothers. To choose a great and respected person would be too easy for us to accept, or too difficult for that person who might be demoted and declared mad. Again, in George Adamski were all the virtues and failings of this planet, slightly over-lifesized. So that one could recognize an aspect of oneself in him and judge from a more personal basis.

To assess the validity of his claims is still difficult. I am personally completely satisfied that his photos and early contacts are completely authentic and will in time be proven by later events. Some of his claims take a lot of swallowing. But just when you had decided to write him off as a babbling, something turns up to substantiate them. For instance, when I first visited him in 1954 he spoke of the Van Allen Belts, and the 'Fireflies in space' as later seen by the cosmonauts. Neither of these were known at the time. The last time I saw him he calmly announced 'I saw Pope John yesterday.' Well, as it happened I was able to get independent confirmation that this was true. John gave him a beautiful gold medallion effigy of himself which as far as I know has never yet been released and is only given to the most special people. George claimed to have given John a sealed package from the Brothers with advice for the conduct of the Council. Certainly the way the Church has behaved since then is very much in line with the Brother's policies.

That was the maddening thing about George. Just as you thought you had at last caught him in a whopper, something would turn up to substantiate his claim.

I remember two occasions on successive nights at Palomar when I saw a tiny golden remote control disk leave rapidly. On the second occasion we were talking on his patio just after dark when I got a tremendous feeling of being watched. I turned around just in time to see a tiny golden disk not more than fifty feet away, as it shot upward in a trail of light. George laughed, and I said: "Thank God our conversation has been clean the last twenty minutes."

He refused to ask me on a 'contact' with him and at the time it peeved me greatly. But I realized later that I was in no fit spiritual state for such an experience and had I been taken aboard a saucer I doubt if I'd have been a very successful prophet afterwards for my ego is highly susceptible to spiritual aggrandisement. Many who have had genuine contacts have gone very odd, forming new religions and in fact doing everything the Brothers desire least. I doubt I would have been any exception.

One thing I liked about George was his utter down-to-earthiness. I don't think he ever suffered from spiritual pride — from abuse, from strain, from many other things yes, but despite the warring human factions which grew up among his followers, there was always a great modesty and sense of his own unimportance in a scheme of such vastness and splendor.

I don't suppose he will mind me telling this, now that he has cast off the fine old body, but he once showed me the most extraordinary birthmark. His navel was not like a human navel at all. It was a huge solar disk with deeply cut rays extending out about six inches all around it, from waist to groin. What this signifies I have no idea — unless it is truly the sign of a 'Child of the Sun.'

Political factions are clamoring against each other for the right of opinion; philosophers and scientists are arguing about the truth of their various theories; all over the world conflicting thought centers are springing up, each professing itself the only dispenser of the absolute truth and man finds himself wondering just what is truth.

As long as man has been in existence I suppose he has sought for truth without recognizing it when he had it firmly in his grasp.

Many generations ago when the Roman Empire was at the height of her glory and the weight of her dominance was felt by a host of people there arose in her midst a master mind who said to those oppressed "You shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free". And the people eager for deliverance, cried out, "The truth! Give us the truth that we may be free!" They were told the meaning of truth but they could not comprehend and so we hear the echo of those words and of the billions like them quivering down the ages with an insistent appeal - "The Truth! what is truth?"

And for every such questioning voice there is another calling, "Follow me, I alone can give you the Real Truth!" And blindly the people follow, little knowing or understanding the purpose of life.

So to you of this present day - you who have acquired much knowledge of many things, I ask, "What is truth?"

Those who are idealistically inclined will answer, "It is reality!" And those who are founded upon a cold scientific basis will answer "Fact" Others will say that truth is that which is opposed to untruth or is that which is good. To those who gave the first two answers I shall say you are correct so far as you have gone but I shall proceed to catch you in a net of your own weaving. The latter answer that truth is that which is good is utterly misconceived and evasive.

Let us, therefore, get down to real analysis. Just what is the truth about truth? You have said that it is Reality and if I were to ask you to define reality you would be compelled to admit that it is that which has actual existence, and yet you speak of the real and unreal. You have a set standard for Reality. Does not everything that is known have apparent existence? How else should it have become known?

What of those that say truth is fact- explaining further that it is that which can be proven. Let me ask you this-proven to whom and by what and for how long? Again you must have a set standard of discrimination. Must it be proven by man's laws or theories that have already been given recognition? Then you are putting a limitation on truth. Must it be proven to all people or only to one who is able to see beyond the perception of his fellow-men? Proof can only go so far as a man will accept and truth to each man is only that which he has experienced either by mental realization or physical expression, and yet truth is universal. It is the sum total of action. Every smallest quivering frequency in the whole cosmos is truth-true because it perpetuates action. I shall bring all of my statements down to a perfectly logical, matter-of-fact foundation.

Most of the world's intolerance is due to the misconception of truth.. Men fight to death for their individual concept of it when a little wisdom would show them that they are only a step apart in the same hall of learning, but due to the fact that every individual intelligence has a slightly different degree of understanding truth to each is slightly different. Intolerance is a mark of ignorance, for a developed intelligence is able to view sequences of action that shows each separate action to be relatively true.. And because all sides of a question are understood he is bound by none. This type of intelligence does not condemn those who see only one phase of the truth. Instead he will point out the pitfalls or limitations that follow the course of thought that the individual is indulging in.

Truth is action-the whole action of which every part is true. Small truths lead into greater truths and one small truth cast out as false can block the progress of a civilization, as has been shown by the history of the past.

Because men do not understand the meaning of truth and are therefore intolerant, there has been a span of over a thousand years of scientific darkness that might have been used to bring the slowly evolving civilization to a higher standard of human expression.

"You shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free". And the truth is that all things are true-true in a relative sense. I grant you-relative to all other parts, but until men recognize and give due consideration to the Cause of all actions they will never be free. Only in uniting our efforts, acknowledging a common purpose can we bring civilization to a unified state of understanding and progress.

Truth is like a great picture puzzle-a mosaic, as it were, and each man's individual expression is a part of the total composition.. The mature individual realizes life as a succession of duties to be performed. Because there are diversified concepts of life does not mean that only one can be correct. No, all are true.. Whatever is conceived in the mind of man is true to him for the moment just as every act of nature is true whether it be of creation or disintegration. Man's ideas may be used unwisely because he has not enough knowledge to use constructively in relation to other truths, but that does not mean that the results establish a fact.

Our purpose in life, then, is not to personally judge between the true and the untrue but to so coordinate our own being with nature that we may unite the knowledge of Cause and Effect.

News of interest:

Over the last several months, a great deal of renewed attention and exposure has been directed towards the 1947 UFO incident in Roswell, New Mexico. For those unfamiliar with this event, briefly, this incident involved the recovery, examination and subsequent military cover up of several crashed extraterrestrial space craft and the bodies of their occupants. In part, selected circumstances concerning Roswell were accurately recounted, however, in the attempt to sensationalize an already momentous event, a standard assortment of misinformation was also incorporated. True several UFO's did malfunction, one disintegrating - covering the landscape with debris - due to internal pressurization problems and another crashing primarily intact nearby. GEORGE ADAMSKI **the first ambassador** **to outer space?**

THE GIGANTIC CIGAR SHAPED ship glided silently over the blistering noon desert. The hum from its huge generators electrified the air, sending small desert animals scurrying for their holes in lightning terror. . . .

Directly beneath the large UFO, George Adamski hurriedly set up his six-inch reflecting telescope, attaching a camera. The hair on the back of his neck stood straight up as he began snapping pictures in the charged atmosphere.

A quarter of a mile away Adamski's four companions stood aghast, their eyes glued to powerful binoculars, watching as the orange-topped object glided silently over a nearby mountain ridge. The lack of wings and tail assembly, and the strange undecipherable insignia on the side made them think of an extra-terrestrial spaceship.

"Suddenly I saw this saucer come in," Adamski later told me "In the meantime, Air Force jets had spotted the cigar-shaped craft and began closing."

Adamski, remaining cool throughout the entire display of aerial bedlam, finished his roll of film.

He had just begun packing up his photo gear when he heard a man hail him from a short distance away. Adamski's first thought was that the man was merely a rock hound, but this judgement proved incorrect. Adamski signaled for his companions to take care of his telescope, and began walking toward the stranger.

"The closer I got to him, the odder I felt," recalled Adamski. "I was cautious, but not frightened."

Upon close inspection Adamski found the stranger's clothing to be not unlike his own. Long, blond tresses hung down to his shoulders. He was about 5'6" tall, weighed 135 pounds, and by Adamski's judgement, looked approximately 28-years-old.

The stranger's high forehead and finely chiselled nose gave him a statuesque appearance against the noontime desert sun. His grey-green eyes, set in a face that was "nearly as hairless as that of a baby", presented a striking picture. The stranger wore no watch, ring, nor other ornamentation.

When the two were at arm's length, the stranger stuck forth his hand in a friendly gesture, but instead of shaking hands in the normal manner, he just rubbed his palm against Adamski's.

Realizing that time was expiring, Adamski asked his new acquaintance from whence he hailed. But the visitor only shook his head and flashed an apologetic expression, indicating that he did not understand.

So they communed by telepathy!

Adamski explains how he pictured a planet in his mind and pointed to the sun. Immediately he received the message that the stranger was from Venus.

Through telepathy, gestures, and sign language, Adamski slowly amassed the information that

Orthon's objectives were friendly, although he was concerned with "radiations from our nuclear tests".

The Venusian then pointed to a nearby hill where his "saucer" was parked, and explained that he used this *scout ship* to hop back and forth between earth and the gigantic blunt-end *mother ship* Adamski had photographed earlier.

The visitor revealed that he came from Venus and that the *mother ship* was propelled through space by magnetic energy; that many landings had preceded this one and many would follow. Venusians follow the laws of the Creator instead of the laws of materialism as earth-men do, Adamski later claimed, and was pointedly informed that several space visitors had been killed as the result of thoughtless actions by men of earth.

"For this reason", Adamski was told, "extra-terrestrial visitors do not land in populated areas be-

cause they would be 'torn to pieces'."

SUDDENLY ADAMSKI REMEMBERED a box Brownie camera he had brought with him. But the space man objected. It seems that he occasionally does "undercover work" on earth, and he feared he might be recognized.

To other questions, the stranger revealed that all inhabitants of other planets are humanoid in appearance; that they have "kidnapped" many willing earthlings; that all of the planets within our solar system are inhabited.

After about one hour of discussion, Adamski was telepathically impressed that the Venusian must leave. Pointing to his feet, the visitor suddenly exploded in an alien tongue — one that resembled Chinese and "one of the ancient languages spoken here on earth."

Adamski surmised that the visitor's feet held some special sig-

nificance. Then the space man stepped aside, and — behold; — there were two deep impressions containing a quantity of lines, circles and symbols. Adamski claimed that the symbols contained astronomical and historical information.

Then the two men walked to the hovering scout ship. Adamski described it as resembling a glass bell rather than a "saucer." He says it was translucent, of "exquisite color," dome-shaped with three huge ball-shaped objects on the underside, and about 35 feet in diameter. The dome supposedly housed a heavy coil, which glowed when power surged through it.

With Orthon aboard, the craft suddenly glowed a blinding white and flashed away over a nearby mountain, where Adamski had observed the mother ship hovering.

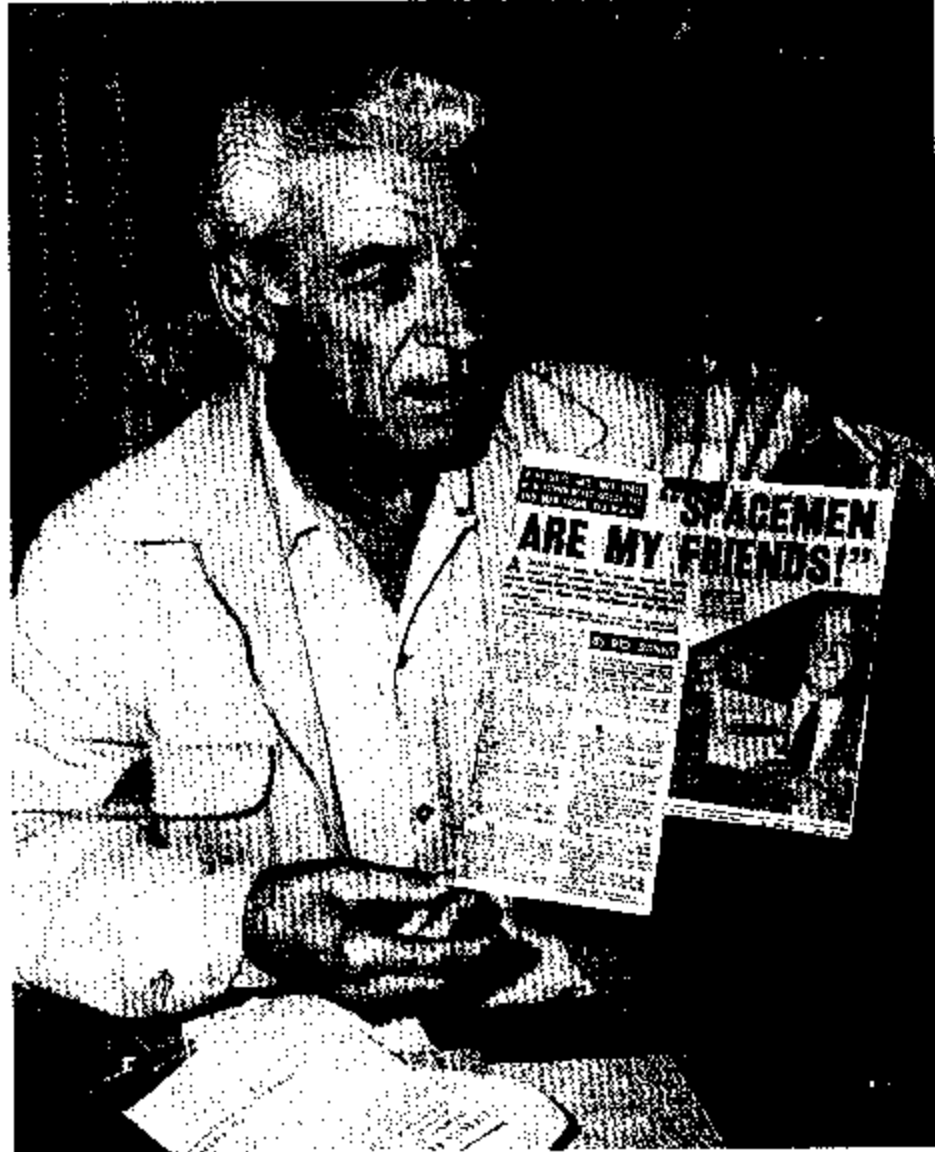
Thus, on November 20, 1952, George Adamski became our first alleged ambassador to outer space.

During his long and colorful career, George Adamski, who has never had one day of public schooling in his life, wore the hats of philosopher, student, teacher, and saucer researcher.

Adamski's first UFO book, *Flying Saucers Have Landed*, which turned out to be one of the most highly publicized books of our time, was printed in 18 different languages, and shows better than a quarter-million copies sold since its first publication. Its sequel, *Inside the Space Ships*, has sold over 100,000 copies.

Born of a Polish father and an Egyptian mother, Adamski chose to live at Palomar Gardens, a quiet California retreat eleven miles from the world's largest telescope.

George Adamski served two enlistments in the U.S. Army prior and during World War I. His life from that time until 1928, when he began teaching philosophy in Los Angeles, is a mystery.

In 1933 he moved to Laguna Beach, California, and acquired a following by lecturing over the air. Adamski imparted the priceless knowledge of ancient laws "known by occidental people today but seldom found outside of Oriental Philosophy."

It was not long before George Adamski adopted the title of "Professor," an honor supposedly conferred upon him by his students. He was also esteemed by the gift of a six-inch Tinsley reflecting telescope, which was to become famous a decade later for supposedly having taken the first photographs of a space ship from another world.

In 1944 Adamski purchased 20 acres on the southern slopes of

Palomar Mountain, "on the advice", he says, "of scientist friends who had been instructing me in the field of astronomy and the operation of the 18-inch Schmidt telescope atop Mt. Palomar."

On October 9, 1946 Adamski says he saw his first "space ship." Observing the sky during a meteor shower, Adamski spotted a large, black, dirigible-shaped object which he at first mistook for an American secret weapon.

August, 1947 provided the first mass sighting for Adamski and his friends. 184 flying saucers, no less, traveling in "squadrons of 32."

In late 1949 Adamski claims he was approached by four government scientists who wished to enlist his help in obtaining "photographs of strange craft flying

through space." Soon Adamski came up with two photographs, which he claims to have turned over to J. P. Maxfield and G. L. Bloom of the Point Loma Naval Electronics Laboratory. Adamski received his first newspaper publicity when personnel at the laboratory denied ever having received the photographs.

The year 1950 was disappointing for Adamski. He was able to photograph only "white spots far out in space."

The next two years were more rewarding, however.

"The spacecraft seem to be moving closer to earth in ever increasing numbers," he reported.

Out of 700 negatives exposed, 18 were good enough to "prove," according to George Adamski, the objects came from outer space.

By this time Adamski was presenting his "proof" to service clubs, his sole stated purpose being "to get people thinking and talking flying saucers." To augment his lecture income he began selling his photographs for 75¢ each.

When Adamski is questioned as to why he was able to come up with so many fine saucer photos when other equally energetic persons ended in dismal failure, he had this to say:

"My pictures aren't exclusive. Large observatories as well as the government agencies also have good, and in some cases better pictures, but they are classified. The average person never gets a look at these photos".

In addition, Adamski claims he actually spends more time sky watching, not to mention the fact that Mt. Palomar lies between two "natural vortexes" (which somehow seems to attract the saucers like flies to sugar).

ADAMSKI ALSO HAS SEVERAL opinions as to why the government suppresses pictures of flying saucers. "First it would upset the ap-

plecart of our school system too fast. And the economic system could be upset if too much information is given suddenly."

However, by 1951 and 1952, our enthusiastic sky watcher decided that photographs of distant space ships were not enough, and he initiated several excursions into the desert, where rumor had it that the "little people" were abounding aplenty.

It was on one of these trips which produced not only many photographs, but Adamski's now-famous meeting with his Venusian near the small town of Desert Center, California.

After the historic meeting, all was quiet until December 13, 1952. Suddenly at 9 a.m. Adamski was awakened by the roar of jet planes circling overhead. Outside he observed "an iridescent glass-like craft" hovering 400 feet above a nearby valley.

Adamski took four pictures of the saucer, after which it approached to within 100 feet of the photographer. A porthole opened, and an extended hand dropped a film holder which Adamski had given his friend on the November 20th meeting. Then the hand waved, and the spaceship sped away.

Upon development, these negatives comprised an essential part of Adamski's best-seller, *Flying Saucers Have Landed*. The book also contained the following affidavit, signed by all the witnesses to Adamski's contact with outer space:

"We, the undersigned, do solemnly state that we have read the account herein of the personal contact between George Adamski and a man from another world, brought here in his Flying Saucer 'Scout' ship. And that I was party to, and witness to the event as herein recounted."

Upon close questioning two of the witnesses decided they did not quite see everything Adamski reported. One failed to see the flying saucer, but did see a "flash" about the time the saucer was supposed to have taken off. The other witness failed to see Adamski talking with the spaceman because he may have been "looking a few degrees



off."

There were many divergent views on Adamski's photographs.

In a much publicized statement, Peverly Marley, a noted Hollywood cinematographer, claimed that if Adamski's pictures had been faked, they exhibited the cleverest trick photography he had ever seen.

The Air Force's Air Technical Intelligence Center in Dayton, Ohio felt differently, however. Edward J. Ruppelt, who headed the official flying saucer investigative body at the time, Project Blue Book revealed the official verdict:

"They could be genuine, of course, but they could have been easily faked by a ten-year-old with a Brownie camera."

While Adamski has had many alleged contacts since the meeting with the Venusian (he claims at least seven), he produced no more photographs that showed anything more than white blotches against a darkened background.

DURING ONE OF THESE "contacts," he met two other space brothers who identified themselves as Firkon and Zuhl. These experiences were recorded in Adamski's second best-seller, *Inside the Space Ships*.

Although Adamski maintains that he has been neither to the

moon nor any other planet to date, he does claim to have been granted a trip into outer space aboard the cigar-shaped mother ship.

In their airborne "laboratory," the cooperative brothers turned a television scanner onto the moon, which was a mere 40,000 miles distant at the time. Peering down at the dim screen, Adamski's eyes suddenly widened.

"You will find bases up there," he told me. "You're going to find dwellings — not palatial, but nice dwellings where the people that maintain the bases are living. I even saw what appeared to be an animal through an opening in a forest or brush. It ran across this little opening and it looked like it could have been a small dog. Maybe it wasn't a dog at all, but it looked something like a small dog would look running across an open path."

But life on the moon didn't startle the amateur astronomer.

"Watch for movement in the craters", Dr. Johnson and Dr. Wilson of Mt. Palomar allegedly told Adamski. "The movement in

the craters cannot be anything but air."

On this issue Adamski stands alone, for astronomers are virtually unanimous in their opinion that the moon cannot support life. They state that the moon lacks both water vapor and atmosphere, both of which are prime requisites for anything but the most elementary organisms.

Not only does Adamski claim there is life on the moon, but also gigantic forests which appear as nothing more than dark blotches to our scientists.

In Adelaide, Australia, on his first lecture tour, Adamski said he met a space woman. She was employed as a lawyer for a steamship company.

Adamski claims that many space people live as humans on this planet. Several thousand, at least. (He is quick to point out there are supposedly ten million persons on this planet whose origins are unknown).

Adamski also asserts there have been some 2,500 contacts, 800 or 900 of which are genuine.

"The others have merely had mental experiences", he asserts.

Of the many space visitors Adamski has met, the majority, he claimed are Venusian scientists.

"If we can accept this thing, we have a chance to go farther than any civilization in history,"

Adamski claimed. "The visitors didn't come here to be worshipped. They just want to help."

Such unorthodox thinking provoked a near-riot among 300 students when Adamski lectured at a university in Zurich, Switzerland. The students apologized the following day, and Adamski dutifully explained that they had been the victims of an "international conspiracy" which was attempting to discredit him.

The highlight of Adamski's European tour, however, was the warmhearted reception accorded him by Queen Julianna of the Netherlands.

While the press was quick to point out that Julianna was a kook — she had employed a faith healer five years earlier to help cure her younger daughter of partial blindness — this did not deter the Queen in her mission.

The Queen with her husband, Prince Bernhard — a noted aviator — and an assortment of Dutch Air Force personnel, astronomers, and physicists listened intently to what Adamski had to say.

What the results of the historic meeting were never came to light, but Adamski regarded it as a triumph — not to himself, but "for the cause". "It gave prestige to the flying saucer program for the first time," Adamski pro-

claimed.

Following this world tour, Adamski came to the conclusion that foreign countries are more respective to space visitors than is America.

"There have been a number of landings in Russia," he stated. "They even dined with the visitors — treated them like humans should treat humans — and naturally they learned a lot that way."

While Adamski himself was a contactee, he pointed out briskly that he has only contempt for the majority of psychos, crackpots, and confidence men that put forth this claim. He considered himself a lone wolf, and took pride in the fact that he never belonged to a flying saucer club or attended a convention.

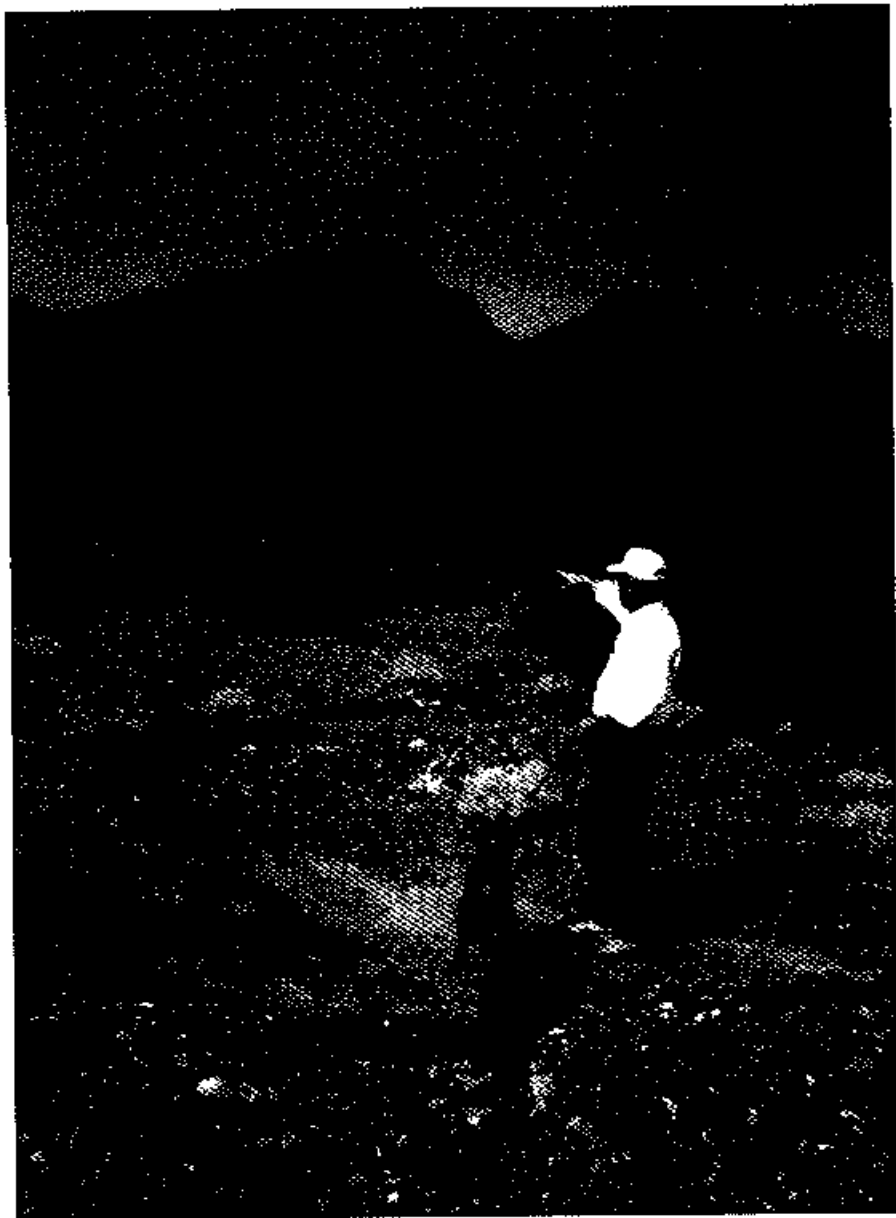
It has been estimated that 105,000 people attended his lectures during his world tour, and that another 45 million heard him speak over radio and television. And, while he claimed to have netted no income from his world tour, it is commonly believed that his books have netted him a small fortune.

Most flying saucers, Adamski said, hail from our solar system. And as far as he knows, all the visitors are friendly.

"While it would be possible for cultures less developed than ourselves to invent spaceships and visit our planet for selfish purposes", Adamski explained, "none have shown up to date." In the past years the whole program of the space visitors has changed, he continued. The idea now is to place many space men in high scientific and government jobs, thus upgrading our technology and getting us into space as soon as possible.

"There could be a million contacts and billions of sightings, and it wouldn't convert the world. But if just one of our spaceships lands on a planet and brings back word of life and civilization, it would do more good than millions of saucers in mass landings. And it wouldn't frighten the people to death, either."

Thus declared George Adamski. Philosopher, student, teacher, saucer researcher. ■



Mojave Time Warp

Not long ago, my good-sport wife Mary, our intrepid Welsh Terrier Buddtu, and I slipped uncertainly back in contactee time. In California's Mojave Desert, land of the unearthly Joshua tree, impossibly surreal near-far peaks, and determinedly unprepossessing towns and near-ghosts of towns, you never can be quite sure Where-When you are.

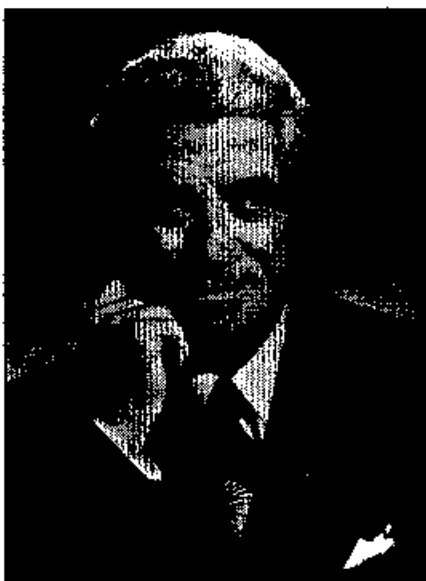
In 1952, "Professor" George Adamski claimed to have been drawn here, to a place precisely 10.2 miles northeast of the now almost-ghost-town of Desert Center, to meet Space Brother Orthon of Venus. Today, the spot is all but the same as it was,

and standing at highway's edge in the palpable silence, one would not be surprised to see Orthon's "scout ship" soar over the looming mountains.

Instead, some miles to the northwest, in the town of Joshua Tree, there's the Carousel Café, down the road a piece from the Institute of Mentalphysics. The diner and especially its sign seem to have been fashioned in the image of Orthon's ship as depicted in photographs created by Adamski. The place might once have been called Flying Saucer Eats, and it still suggests something both wondrous and silly. When one learns from the owner that the shape is really that of a hamburger on a

plate, with pickles on the side, now painted over, what we think of as Here and Now reality wavers back into semi-focus—for a while.

Somewhat farther northwest lies Giant Rock. For more than two decades, beginning in 1954, the hulking seven-story boulder was the scene of George Van Tassel's annual Interplanetary Spacecraft Conventions, where thousands gathered to listen to tales told by leading flying saucer Space Brother contactees, including Van Tassel, wildly contradicting each other and yet somehow mutually supportive. Today, cataclysmically shorn of one-eighth of its bulk, it is splattered with graffiti, some inspired,

most sub-pedestrian. Other than the defaced Rock, all that remains of Back When is the foundation slab of the Giant Rock Airport Café and, nearby, the shade of the dirt airstrip.

Still, there is a “feel” about the place. Or is it just the impact of the eerie quiet, set shivering but not quite banished by guns booming on the adjacent Marine Corps training base?

Not far off, the Integratron dome glitters white in the relentless sun, a mock Palomar. It is double-fenced in one corner of what used to be Van Tassel’s ranch, the place a bit forlorn yet seemingly charged with some quirky energy. We are told the Integratron, a rejuvenation machine, was built to specs channeled by Van Tassel from extraterrestrial starship commanders, with a dash of Nikola Tesla’s ideas thrown in for good measure. After almost two decades of work, it remained unfinished when Van Tassel died in 1978. It is now open for public tours, offers rejuvenating “sound baths,” and is “available for private rental.”

The Good Ol’ Days live! Or at least some haunting, quantum-physically smeared, trapped-between-times semblance of them does. This is a region where the line between Here and Now and Where? and When? is a blurry one, which may be what drew those who created the contactee movement and their followers. That “something” is still here today, and

those who seek it with an open mind and a sense of nostalgic adventure can still experience it.

Adamski Meets Orthon— Or Does He?

A good place to start is the spot just beyond the west edge of State Highway 177 where, on November 20, 1952, earthling and Space Brother may or may not have met for the first time. Forty-eight years later, almost to the day, we drove north from Desert Center, a thriving rest stop and refuge from the relentless Mojave heat be-

fore U.S. Highway 60-70 was replaced and downgraded to a frontage road by Interstate 10. I carefully clocked the northeastward miles, while comparing the look of and lay of the mountains to our left with the less-than-precise descriptions and meeting-site photo in Adamski and Desmond Leslie’s *Flying Saucers Have Landed* (1953). Nine miles...ten...ten-point-two—precisely ten-point-two miles, yet everything else the Professor gave us was so vague. Where? When? But, yes, this really looked like the spot, or at least close enough.

Here it was that Adamski was dropped off by his secretary Lucy McGinnis to await a long-hoped-for rendezvous with one of those whose ships he had been photographing for several years. They had been guided there by a huge cigar-shaped mothership that had drifted into view as they and four others picnicked a half-mile or mile farther up the road, depending upon which of Adamski's tellings one goes by.

Soon after McGinnis headed back to the others, Adamski was hailed by a man

with long blond hair clad in brown coveralls, not usual 1952 Earth styles. They conversed by sign language and some form of telepathy, and Adamski was told the man, whose name he later learned was Orthon, came from Venus and that he and his saucer-flying brethren were here because they feared we would destroy ourselves in an atomic war. (These days, UFO pilots fret about environmental disaster.) Adamski was privileged to get a close look at the exterior of Orthon's ship—a beautifully

translucent, bell-shaped craft that became the archetypal 1950s flying saucer.

All this was viewed by Adamski's friends up the road, who signed affidavits to that effect, although as time went by, some of them recanted or hedged. I wanted to see if it were possible to view the meeting spot from where the sorta-witnesses waited. We drove a half-mile and then a mile further up Highway 177. At each point, I looked back. A mountain spur blocked the view from both locations. The watchers might have seen the Venusian flying saucer arrive and leave, but there was no way they could have observed Adamski's chat with Orthon or the low-hovering craft.

So did the meeting really take place? Does it really matter? It's a bit of early saucer lore that, taken on its own terms, is magical. Stand beside the road on the ground where it did or did not happen. Imagine the peculiar energy of the place. You will see what I mean.

Not Just Any Rock

The anchor, focus, and energy source of the area's "contactee plane" is Giant Rock, a few miles north of the little town of Yucca Valley. This massive granite monolith, on land controlled by the U.S. Bureau of Land Management, is said to be the world's largest free-standing boulder, likely still a legitimate boast even after a huge chunk of it sheared off and crashed to the ground with a rumbling roar on February 21, 2000.

The BLM said Giant Rock was the victim of a combination of water freezing in its fissured flanks, temperature extremes, and local earthquakes. (There was a magnitude 4.4 quake centered nearby just two hours before the Rock calved.) Others have more exotic ideas arising from New Age interpretations of local Indian legends and, of course, UFO lore. Tongue firmly in cheek, Michele Pinney, a reporter on Yucca Valley's *Hi-Desert Star*, told me she thought "a UFO probably showed up, found no one around, and zapped the Rock to remind us to be more polite in the future." Pinney was joking, but other locals who offered similar notions were not.

The Rock is an interesting and scenic

25-minute drive from the center of Yucca Valley. To be even more precise than George Adamski, beginning at State Highway 62, head 12 miles north on State 242 (Old Woman Springs Road). Hang a right on Linn Road, go east for two miles to the intersection with Belfield Road—that's the Integratron on your right—and continue straight ahead off the pavement onto a good dirt road for about 100 yards, then left on Van's (as in Van Tassel's) Ranch Road, a sandy-dirt track which our two-wheel-drive passenger car handled easily. The Rock is about a mile north from there. (Be sure to bear right when you come to the Y-intersection.)

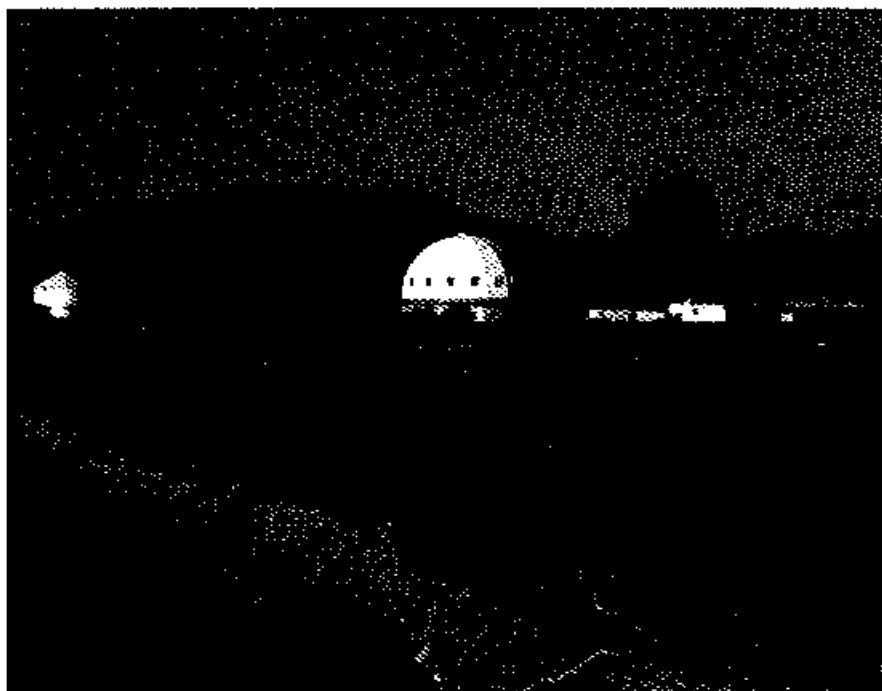
The road climbs a slight rise from which we glimpsed the top of the great landmark. Then, cresting the hill, there it was before us—a silent, hulking monster, crouching in one corner of a flat expanse stretching away to the east and south, with the eerie boulder-heap hills from which it was born close on its western flank.

As we drove slowly down the hill, I surveyed the area. It still looked very much as it did decades ago when the saucering faithful gathered and communed here. The café is gone (bulldozed by the BLM after being ravaged by vandals), and the graffiti and stark whiteness of the Rock's recent wound slashed across my illusion of times past.

Yet, through slightly averted eyes and inwardly tuned ears I felt in touch with the ghosts of expectant crowds, cars and light planes lined up along the near side of the airstrip, and tables and stalls from which such marvelous characters as Gray Barker, Orfeo Angelucci, Frank Stranges, Dana Howard, Dan Fry, and Truman Berthurn peddled their baffle-gabbed enlightenment. Was that the voice of Professor Adamski, or perhaps George Hunt Williamson, carried on the breeze from the elevated speaker's platform in front of the Rock? No, just the cries of some kids scrambling on the tumble-down hillside above, the Here and Now crowding in again.

Mulder? Scully? Is That You?

As we drove back to the Integratron, the present receded, and I slipped back to when George Van Tassel spent about

\$42,000 in donations constructing the non-metallic (no nails, screws, iron, or steel), 38-foot-high, 50-foot-diameter domed structure. The shell of the rejuvenator went up in 1959. Later, when weird images and television signals from other times appeared inside, Van Tassel discovered his building was also a time machine. (Was this the explanation for my drifting back and forth across the years?)

Following his channeled instructions, Van Tassel worked out the Integratron's geometry and sited it precisely (there's that word again) with respect to Egypt's Great Pyramid and Giant Rock—which, according to him, creates and rests at the center of a miles-wide magnetic vortex. Van Tassel claimed the Integratron, when finished, would be able to rejuvenate up to 10,000 people a day—their outward bodies not visibly returned to vigorous youth, but their cells recharged.

Unfortunately—Mary saw it a bit differently—the place was closed the day we visited. If you get there between 2:00 and 4:00 P.M. on one of the first three Sundays of any month, for five bucks (“kids free”) you can tour the building, hear about its history, experience “a demonstration of some of the Dome technologies,” and perhaps be a little bit rejuvenated.

“Quantum music sound baths,” producing an “overall effect on the body like a deep massage on the atomic and molecular levels” and imparting “waves of deep peace and relaxation” seem to be scheduled roughly every month in the spring and fall. Workshops also are held in which “the relationship between healing and earth energies” is explored and participants “learn how to work with these energies to heal ourselves and the planet.” (For more details—or if you just want to try a little remote time-slipping—check out www.integratron.com.)

Gazing at the Integratron glowing in the late-afternoon sun, I seemed to hear voices from the past again. George Van Tassel, Capt. Aura Rhane? No, it was my hungry little dog and at-the-end-of-her-good-sport-rope wife: “Time for a soft-ice-cream cone,” Buddtu woofed. “Time to grab a bite to eat,” she said softly but with finality.

The Here and Now reclaimed me—for a while. ♪
